PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District One is proposing safety improvements to State Road (SR) 33 (Lakeland Hills Boulevard) from North Iowa Avenue to Parkview Place in Lakeland.

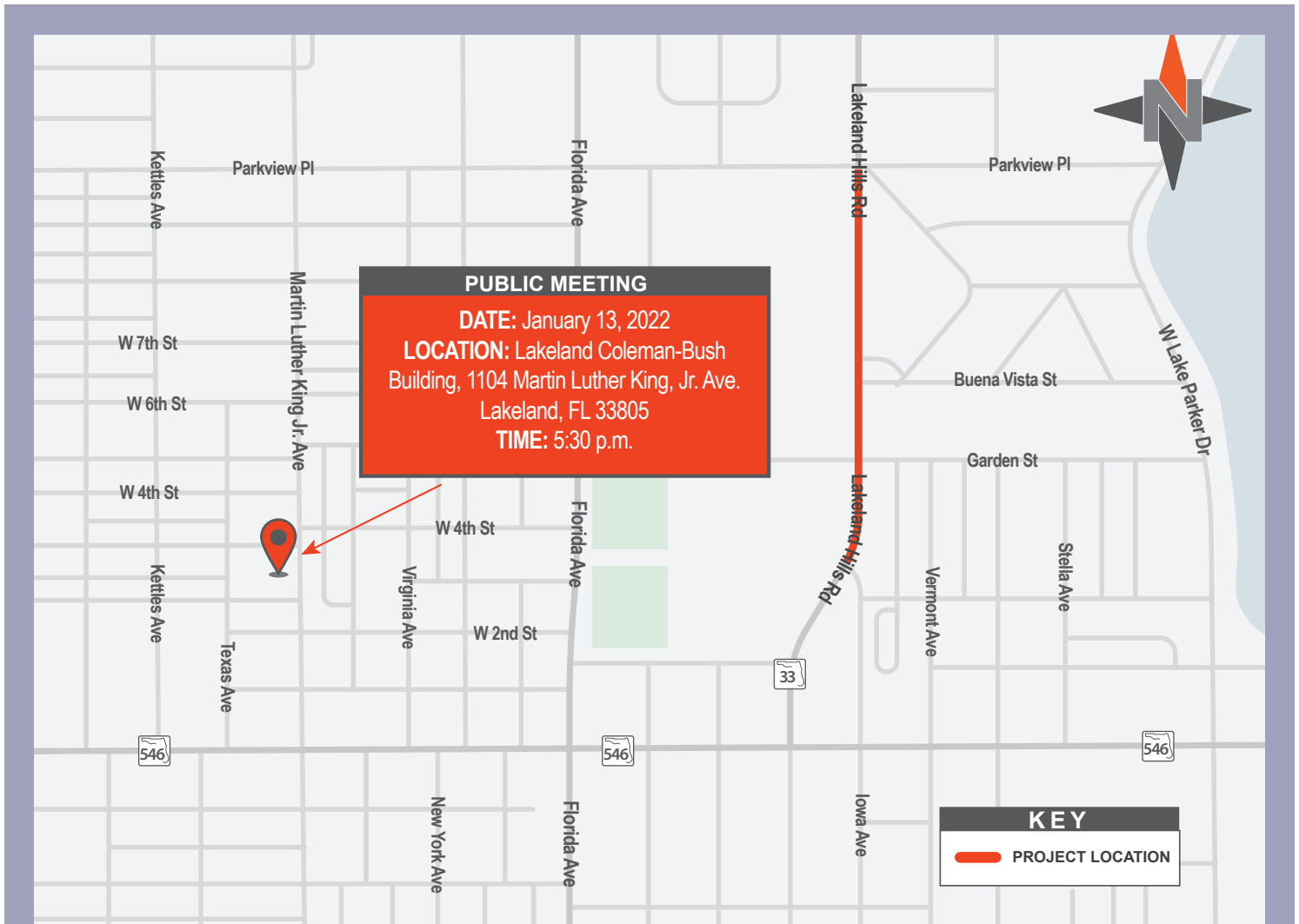
The project proposes replacing the two-way, left turn lane with a raised grass median. Other proposed improvements include repaving and installing traffic separators between the through lane and turn lanes to Parkview Place and Garden Street.

PUBLIC MEETING INFORMATION

The Florida Department of Transportation District One will hold a public meeting as part of the design process for proposed safety improvements on SR 33 (Lakeland Hills Boulevard) from North Iowa Avenue to Parkview Place in Lakeland.

The project proposes replacing the two-way, left-turn lane with a raised grass median along the project corridor to enhance safety. The purpose of the public meeting is to present information and obtain input on the project design.

An Open House from 5:30 - 7:30 p.m. will present an opportunity for in-person attendees to view project exhibits and speak with FDOT staff. There will be a looping presentation at the in-person location which will include details on the project. That same presentation can be viewed by virtual attendees shortly after the meeting opens at 5:30 p.m.
