PD&E STUDY STARTED

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) began a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study to evaluate improvements to the intersection at US 41 and Bonita Beach Road in the City of Bonita Springs, FL in southern Lee County. You may recall a PD&E Study was initiated in 2013 for this intersection and halted in 2014 at the request of the City of Bonita Springs. The City has requested FDOT reinitiate the study of this intersection. The purpose of the study is to address congestion and projected travel demand with the ultimate goals being to enhance mobility, improve safety conditions, and provide for multi-modal features.

During the PD&E study process, FDOT will develop "build" alternatives and provide opportunities for your input. Alternatives under consideration include a variety of intersection-related improvements. We will evaluate each alternative to determine community and environmental impacts, additional right-of-way needs, safety, mobility for all users, and traffic performance. The purpose of the study is to make an ultimate recommendation to advance through the design phase. Throughout this process, FDOT will consider the no-build or "do-nothing" option.

HOW TO GET INVOLVED

You are encouraged to participate in the US 41 and Bonita Beach Road PD&E study, and we invite your questions and comments. We expect to hold a public workshop in Q1 2021 to present the alternatives under consideration for your input. We will send a separate invitation to announce the meeting date and time. We are also available to meet with your group or neighborhood association. At any time, you may provide your comments or request a meeting by contacting FDOT Project Manager, Patrick Bateman, P.E.
