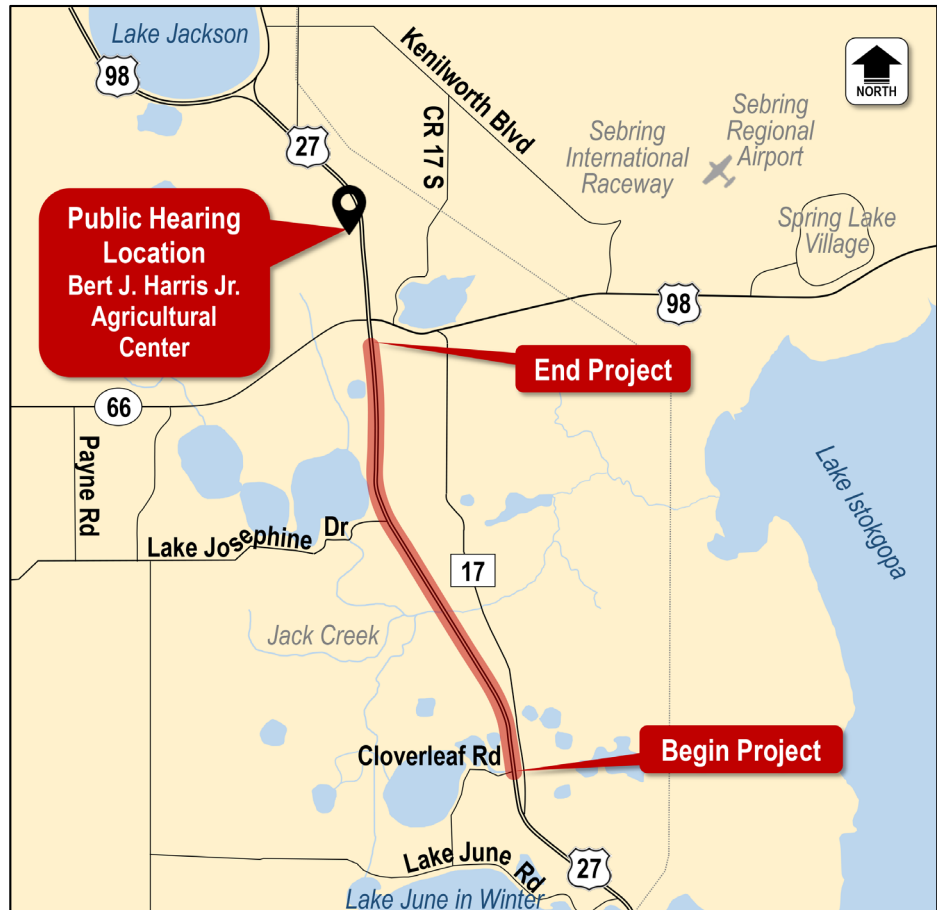

 - Close some median openings
- Replace guardrail
- Improve drainage
