CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

June 2022 Okeechobee County, FL

The Florida Department of Transportation will begin work in July 2022, to construct sidewalks in Okeechobee County for Seminole Elementary School as part of the Safe Routes to School program. The project length is less than a mile and the project limits are identified below.


PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Construct sidewalks along the south side of NW 30th Street from NW 46th Avenue to US 98 and the east side of NW 46th Avenue from south of NW 30th Street to NW 30th Street
- Pedestrian signal improvements at US 98 and NW 30th Street
- Drainage improvements and signing and pavement marking
- Estimated construction cost is \$709,000

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Construction begins July 2022; estimated completion is late 2023
- During construction there may be lane closures on NW 30th Street and NW 46th Avenue from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. and from 4 p.m. to 7 p.m. and on US 98 from 8 p.m. through 5:30 a.m.
