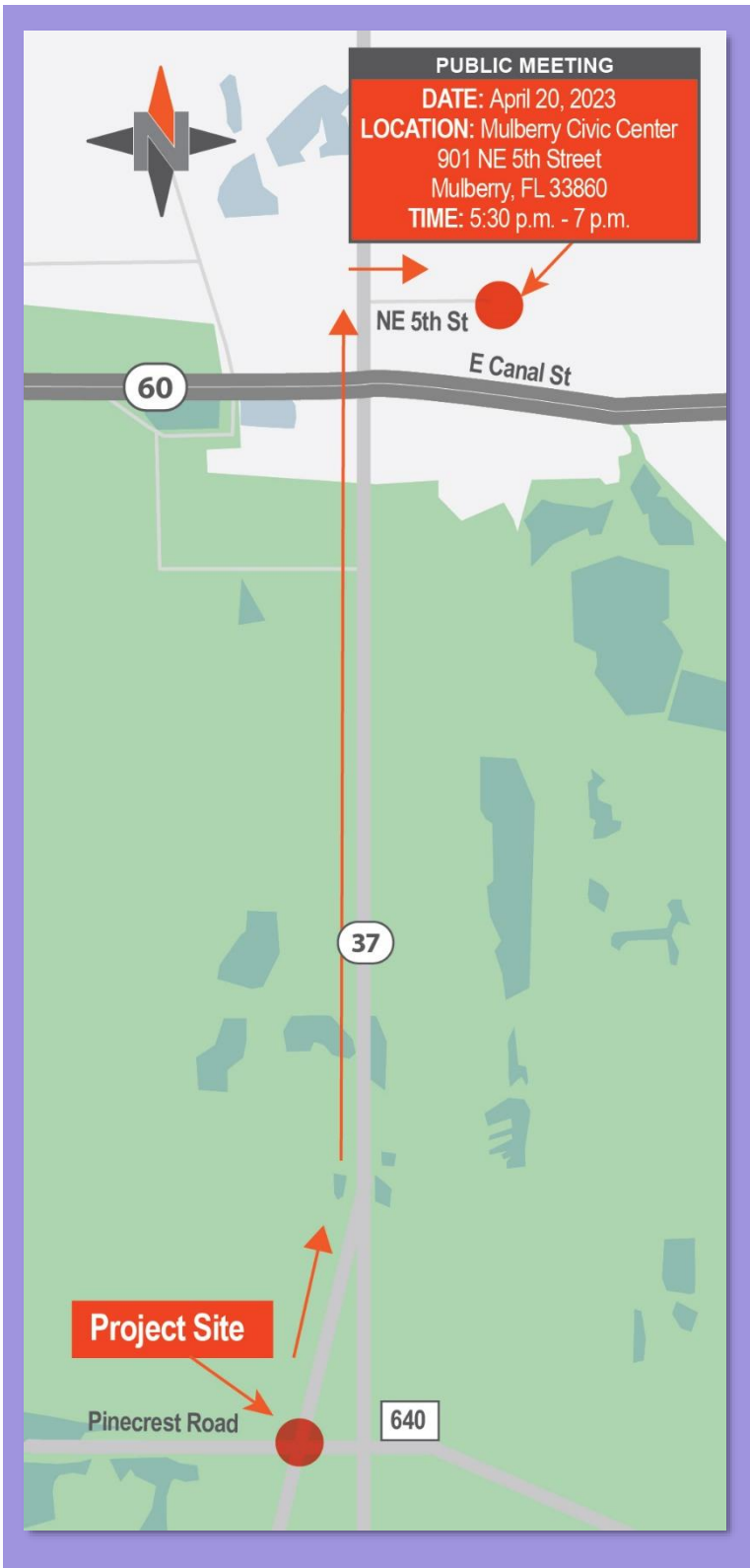
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) District One proposes constructing a roundabout at State Road (SR) 37 at Pinecrest Road (County Road (CR) 640 in Mulberry to increase safety at that intersection.

The proposed project consists of constructing a single-lane roundabout at the intersection of SR 37 and Pinecrest Road. The project would include removing the existing traffic signals, and adding signing, pavement markings, landscaping, and drainage work to fix current deficiencies.

The project will also be designed for future bicycle access, crosswalks, and sidewalk that will extend to the roadway paved shoulders.
