

CR 78 Pine Island Road from West of Little Pine Island Bridge (Bridge No. 120111) to West of Shoreview Drive.



History of Little Pine Island Bridge



- Built in 1977
- Served the community for 47 years
- Was slated to be replaced in 2027.
- September 28, 2022, the bridge is damaged by Hurricane lan.
- Spring 2023, Lee Board of County
 Commissioners voted to incorporate a
 full replacement of the bridge to build a
 more resilient structure for future
 storms as soon as possible.






Severe Storm Damage




- Retaining wall damage (photos)
- Erosion of abutments, exceeded 21 feet
- Repairs of shoreline rocks, extending beyond the rightof-way to protect against erosion
- Damaged sheet pile walls









New Little Pine Island Bridge Design




- The new Little Pine Island Bridge design proposes maintaining two 11-foot-wide travel lanes yet increasing the width of the bridge from 35 feet to 53 feet, extending the shoulder.
- The widening of the existing bridge footprint is required to meet standards and for construction sequencing to allow for two lanes of traffic as soon as possible.
- Construction is anticipated to begin Spring 2024









Construction Phasing








All widening of the existing bridge footprint is required to meet standards and allow for two-lane traffic.




Construction - Phase I






Construction - Phase II

What to Expect During Construction



- Phase 1: Single lane traffic only
- Phase 2 and Phase 3: 2 lanes open
- A temporary traffic signal will be installed during the reconstruction.
- The traffic signal will operate in 3-minute cycles to clear traffic. We encourage motorists to plan additional travel time.






Long-term Benefits to the Community
