

COUNTYLINE ROAD OVER PEACE RIVER BRIDGE

DETAILS

The improvements for this project are for the CR 664 Countyline Road Bridge over Peace River in Polk and Hardee County. This project is located 1.3 miles east of the Bowling Green city limits. The existing bridge, which was constructed in 1958, now has poor substructure which warrants replacement. To mitigate the poor existing bridge conditions, this project recommends replacing the existing two-lane bridge with a new bridge. The existing bridge currently has two 12-foot travel lanes without shoulders, but the new bridge will have two 12-foot travel lanes with additional 8-foot shoulders. The new structure will bring this facility up to current standards and significantly reduce maintenance.

The roadway includes Roadway Design, MOT and Signing and Pavement Marking. The roadway approaches will be resurfaced or reconstructed as needed, with the addition of new guardrail. Additionally, a maintenance connection road will be constructed on the north side of Countyline Road, on the west side of the bridge.

For traffic control during construction, to facilitate the bridge replacement and decrease construction duration a temporary detour will be implemented. Additionally, a temporary trestle bridge is anticipated for the bridge construction and replacement.
