



SR 546 (Memorial Blvd) Concrete Roadway and Trail Projects

Concrete Roadway Reconstruction: from Interstate 4 to Wabash Avenue

Bike Path/Trail: from Chestnut Road East to Brunnell Parkway (south side)

Work begins Monday, July 18, 2016, on a Florida Department of Transportation project to reconstruct the concrete roadway and build a new asphalt trail along SR 546 (Memorial Boulevard) in north Lakeland.

Schedule: July 2016 through Spring 2018
Construction Cost: \$16.2 million
Contractor: GLF Construction Corporation
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The concrete reconstruction project involves removing the old concrete roadway and replacing it with new concrete, from the Interstate 4 ramps to N. Wabash Avenue. Crews will build temporary lanes in the median and shift traffic between the old, temporary and new lanes in order to construct the project. Some side street construction will require short weekend detours as crews work on side street connections.

The new bike path/trail project involves constructing a new 10-foot wide asphalt trail along the south side of SR 546 (Memorial Boulevard) from Chestnut Road East to Brunnell Parkway.

During construction, some driveways will be modified to channel motorists in and out of businesses along the route and keep motorized vehicles off the trail. Lane closures and restrictions during the following hours:

Eastbound: I-4 to Brunnell Parkway - No lane closures from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.

Westbound: Wabash Ave to Kathleen High School - No lane closures from 5 a.m. to 7:30 p.m.

Westbound: Kathleen High School to I-4 - No lane closures from 6 a.m. to 9 a.m. and 4 p.m. to 7 p.m.
