



Congestion at SR 78/I-75 Interchange during peak hours






















EXISTING ROADWAY










PROPOSED ROADWAY TYPICAL SECTION








PROPOSED BRIDGE TYPICAL SECTION








I-75 AT SR 78 INTERCHANGE

• Alternative 1 – propose to widen SR 78 to the north (includes improvements to SR 78/I-75 interchange and intersection improvements where necessary)












PROPOSED ALTERNATIVES


