
Legacy Trail Pedestrian Bridges over SR 72 (Clark Road) and SR 758 (Bee Ridge Road)

Primary purpose is to improve pedestrian and bicycle safety for trail users

- Design provides a min 12-ft clear width shared use path on the bridge and ramp approaches
- ➤ Includes an alignment over SR 72 (Clark Road) that can accommodate the future extension of McIntosh Road
- ➤ The Design Phase was completed in April 2023 and the project is scheduled to advertise in May 2023
- Construction anticipated to begin in Fall 2023
- ➤ The Phase IV construction cost estimated at \$13.2M based on 2/16/2023 estimate for both bridges including Construction Engineering Inspection (CEI)






