



Anna Maria Island Bridge Replacement

SR 789 to Perico Bay Blvd. Financial Project Number 408185-3-52-01

Overview May 2021

Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will replace the existing Anna Maria drawbridge with a new highlevel bridge. The new fixed-span bridge will provide 65 feet of vertical clearance, allowing most vessels to pass under the structure without disrupting traffic on the bridge. The project also includes improvements to SR 64, including the addition of 10-foot sidewalks and 7-foot wide bike lanes on both sides of the road. In addition, improvements to the SR 64 intersection with SR 789 are under consideration. FDOT does not anticipate the need for additional right-of-way.

FDOT has been working with an Aesthetics Advisory Committee to gather community input on decorative features and amenities. The City of Holmes Beach, City of Bradenton Beach, City of Anna Maria, City of Bradenton, Manatee County, and other groups appointed members to the Committee. To date, the Committee has completed its meetings to discuss and make recommendations on certain bridge features and treatments as well as landscaping and hardscaping treatments along the roadway approaches to the bridge. FDOT has facilitated the meetings, provided input, responded to questions and coordinated with maintaining entities to incorporate committee suggestions into the project design.
