# Interstate 75 at US 301 Interchange Improvements



#### **CONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

The Florida Department of Transportation will begin construction on the Interstate 75 (I-75) at US 301 interchange to provide interchange improvements to improve highway operations, safety, and regional mobility.

## Improvements include:

- Reconstruction of the US 301 interchange converting from a partial cloverleaf design to a diamond interchange design
- Replacement and widening of interstate entrance and exit ramps
- New bridges over the Manatee River for a northbound exit ramp and a southbound entrance ramp
- Widen I-75 to provide an auxiliary lane from SR 64 to the new on- and off-ramps
- Construct noise walls at designated locations
- Intersection improvements at: 51st Avenue East 60th Avenue East 19th Street East
- Bicycle and sidewalk improvements
