# Interstate 75 at State Road 72/Clark Road Interchange Improvements



## **CONSTRUCTION PROJECT**

The Florida Department of Transportation will begin construction on the Interstate 75 (I-75) at State Road 72 (SR 72)/Clark Road interchange to provide improvements to the interchange in order to improve highway operations, safety, and regional mobility.

Improvements include:

- Reconstruction of the SR 72 interchange converting to a diverging diamond interchange design
- Reconstruction of interchange entrance and exit ramps
- Widen I-75 northbound to provide an auxiliary lane from SR 72 to the Bee Ridge Road interchange; and, I-75 southbound from Proctor Road to SR 72
- Construct noise walls in the northeast and northwest quadrants of the interchange
- Install new mast arms for the existing traffic signal at Catamaran Drive; and, install a new traffic signal at Queensbury Boulevard
- Construct 7-foot buffered bike lanes and 6-foot sidewalks on SR 72
- Resurface SR 72
