




Project Information and Location

Old Dixie Trail Study Area






Preferred Alternative Chosen

Based on public support, detailed engineering and environmental analysis will continue on the preferred alternative.

Planning Consistency Achieved

Project segmentation to establish funding for design and construction phases.

Segments must have planning consistency before a public hearing can be scheduled.

Public Hearing

The preferred alternative and final analysis will be presented to the public, and they will have the opportunity to provide input on the proposed improvement.

Location Design Concept Acceptance

After the public hearing, the location and conceptual design will be finalized, and the PD&E study will be completed.


Next Phase


