Starting in late June 2016, The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) contractor, Ranger Construction Industries, will make improvements on two sections along SR 70 (Park Street) in Okeechobee County. This project is expected to be complete in spring 2017.

### SR 70 (Park Street) from SW 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue to NW 38<sup>th</sup> Terrace

Crews are constructing a five foot sidewalk along the north side of SR 70 (Park Street) between SW 24<sup>th</sup> Avenue to NW 38<sup>th</sup> Terrace. A pedestrian bridge is being built over Eagle Bay Creek and will connect with the sidewalk. Additional improvements include minor drainage improvements and guardrail replacement.

Work is expected to take place primarily during daytime hours. Minimal lane closures are expected. During lane closures traffic will be directed through the work zone by a traffic flagger.

FDOT will use right-of-way to build this project. Individuals who want to salvage items must remove those items prior to the beginning of construction. If you are unsure of the right-of-way line, please contact Lori Buck, FDOT Public Information, 863-225-0422.

### SR 70 (Park Street) from SE 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SE 31<sup>st</sup> Terrace

Crews are milling and resurfacing SR 70 (Park Street) from SE 16<sup>th</sup> Avenue to SE 31<sup>st</sup> Terrace. Work will take place primarily at night. Single lane closures are expected during nighttime hours.
