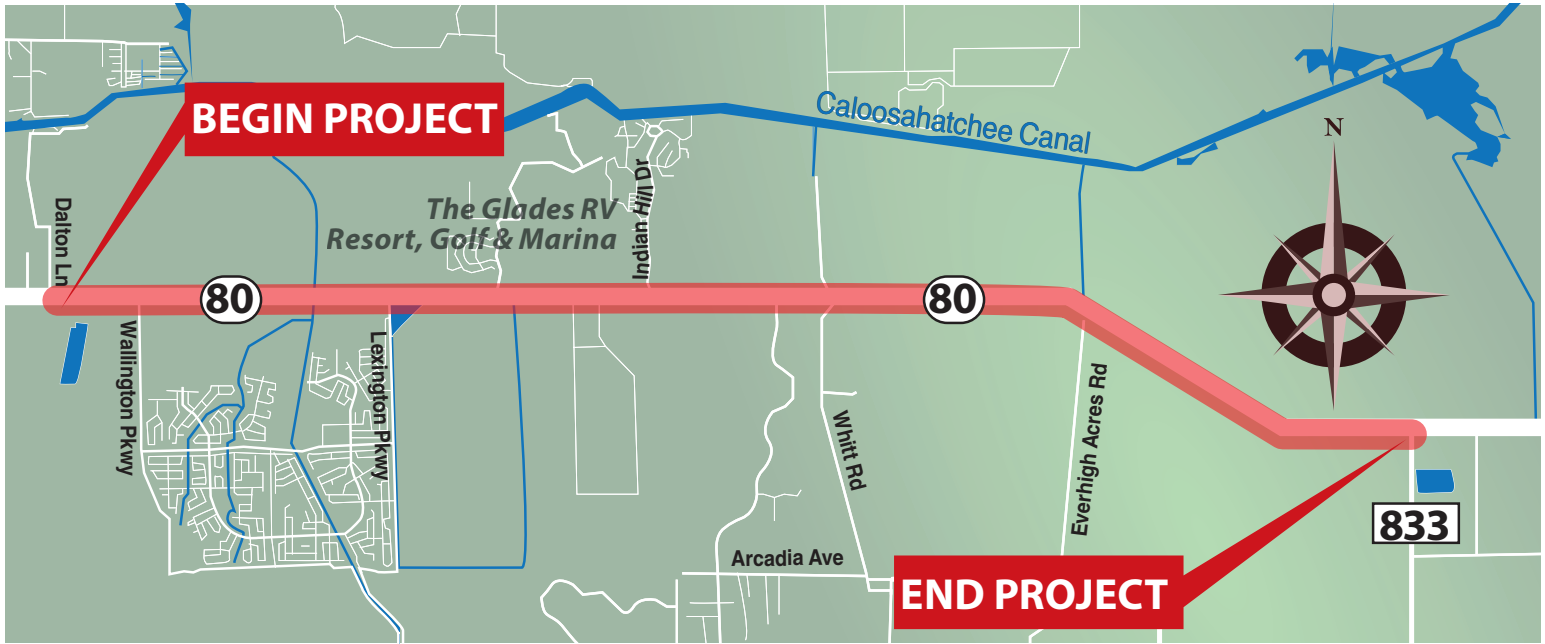




FDOT SR 80 Construction Project

From Dalton Lane to CR 833 in Hendry County
Financial Project IDs: 408286-5-52-01 & 408286-6-52-01

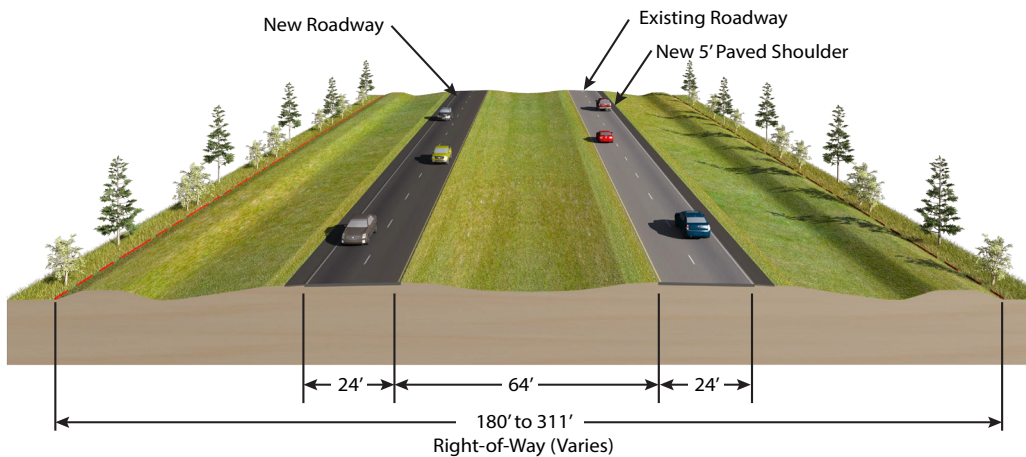


PROJECT DESCRIPTION

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District One, is making improvements to State Road (SR) 80 from Dalton Lane to CR 833 in Hendry County. The project includes widening 11 miles of roadway from an existing two-lane rural roadway into a four-lane divided rural roadway.

FDOT's contractor, Ajax Paving Industries of Florida, is constructing 12-foot wide travel lanes in each direction with a 64-foot grassed median. Additional work includes repaving the current lanes on SR 80 and constructing ten new bridges. Three bridges will require full demolition and removal of the existing bridges to construct the new ones.

Work will also include adding new turn lanes at the major intersections, installing lighting at three intersections, grassed borders along both sides of the roadway, and roadside ditches and off-site ponds to accommodate stormwater runoff. Construction began on May 1, 2017, and the project's estimated completion is summer of 2020.
