## US 41 Venice By-Pass Roadway Improvements from Gulf Coast Boulevard to Bird Bay Drive

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) along with its contractor, Bergeron Land Development, Inc., are making improvements to US 41/Venice By-Pass in Venice beginning early November. Crews will widen US 41 from four lanes to a six-lane roadway from Gulf Coast Boulevard to Bird Bay Drive, improving roadway drainage, installing retention ponds, constructing 7-foot bicycle lanes, and adding concrete sidewalks. The project includes upgrades to lighting, signalization, and bus pads. In addition, crews will relocate/replace water and sewer lines for the City of Venice.



This project is the first of two segments slated to improve the US 41/Venice By-Pass corridor. Completion of the \$16.6 million project is expected in spring of 2018.



FDOT will maintain two lanes of traffic in each direction throughout construction with any necessary lane closures occurring at night.

Motorists should be aware the speed limit within the project limits is reduced from 45 MPH to **40 MPH**.
