

US 41 Resurfacing Project

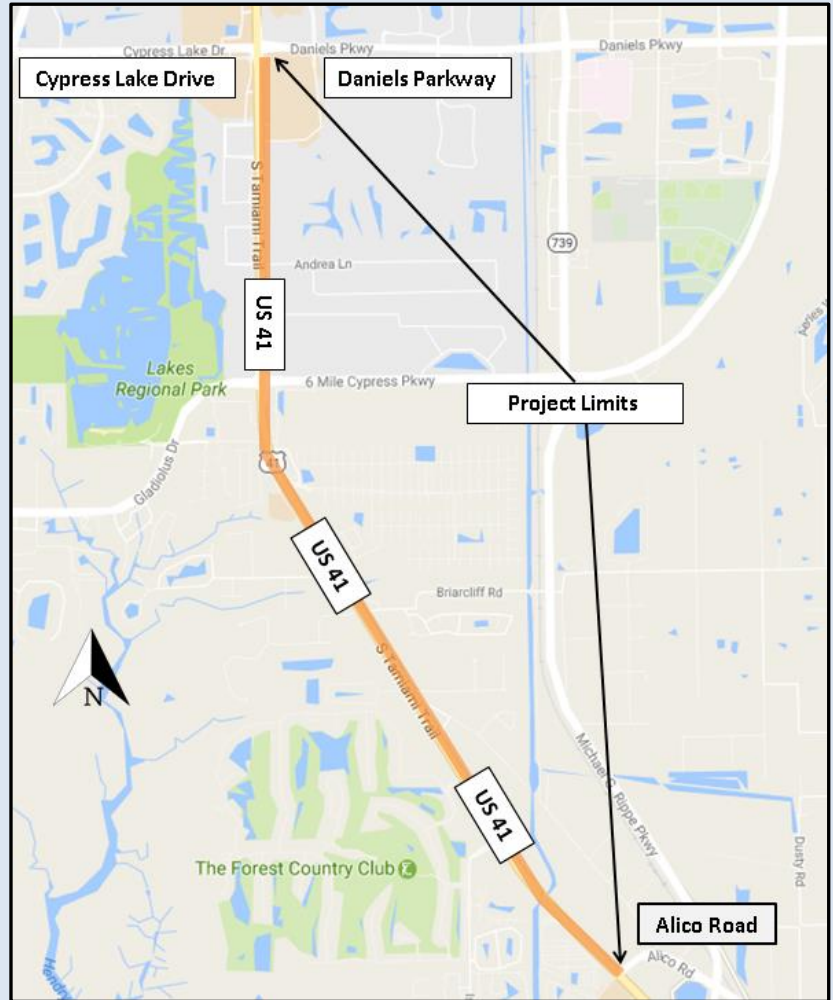
From south of Alico Road to Daniels Parkway

The Florida Department of Transportation's (FDOT) contractor, Preferred Material Inc. begins work on Tuesday, January 2, 2018, to mill and resurface 4.2 miles of roadway on US 41 from south of Alico Road to Daniels Parkway in Lee County. The work will occur during the day and nighttime/overnight hours, weather permitting. Lane closures may occur from 9 p.m. to 6 a.m. Monday through Friday. The project also consists of upgrading signals at seven intersections, adding lighting, and sidewalks. Motorists should expect construction vehicles entering and exiting the roadway. Please use caution and plan extra travel time while driving in this area.
