Business US 41 at the Green Bridge and on Riverside Drive

Landscape and Roadway Improvements Project

The Florida Department of Transportation along with its contractor, Douglas N. Higgins, Inc., are making improvements on Business US 41 at the Green Bridge and along Riverside Drive to 10th Avenue West.

Improvements under this contract consist of constructing a shared use path and sidewalk; improving drainage; installing new decorative lighting; paving the parking lot; constructing new parking spaces with architectural pavers; installing new signing and pavement markings, and installing landscaping with a new irrigation system.

The \$2.3 million project begins Tuesday, May 31 with expected completion in fall 2016.

Landscaping

New landscaping includes Mrs. Shillers Delight, Muhly Grass, Fakahatchee Grass, Coontie, Confederate Jasmine, Perennial Peanut, Royal Palms, Silver Bismark Palms, Sabal Palms, Live Oak, and Form Wax Myrtles.

Lane Closures

Lane closures are not permitted between 6 a.m. - 8 a.m. and from 5 p.m. - 7 p.m. at signalized intersections. Motorists should expect daytime single-lane closures and flagging operations while crews are working. Existing speed limits will be maintained throughout construction.
