CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Beginning Mid-April 2018, the Florida Department of Transportation will start removal and replacement of a section of the Taylor Creek Bridge on North Parrott Avenue (US 441 North), in Okeechobee County. The project limits are approximately one mile. The project area and 46 mile detour route are identified on the project location map.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Removal and replacement of an existing section of the bridge deck
- Installation of pile jackets, which are stay-in-place forms that are installed around the bridge supports and filled with concrete
- Removal and replacement of guardrail
- Pavement markings

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Construction begins Mid-April 2018 and ends in Summer 2018
- Lane closures will be during overnight hours, weather permitting
- Parrott Avenue (US 441) FULL BRIDGE CLOSURE - from 7 p.m., Friday, May 11, to 7 a.m., Monday, May 14
- Please see detour map and follow posted detour signs
- Please drive safely and watch for construction crews in the work zone
- Estimated construction cost is \$400,000
