PROJECT DESCRIPTION

This design project includes reconstruction of the interchange at Daniels Parkway in Lee County. The Department will rebuild the interchange from the existing partial cloverleaf design to a diverging diamond interchange (DDI). The DDI shifts eastbound traffic to the left to allow for improved access to northbound I-75 and shifts westbound traffic to the left to allow for improved access to southbound I-75. This approach reduces the number of phases for the signals and improves delay times. A similar type of interchange has recently been constructed and is now in operation at I-75 / University Parkway.

PROJECT BENEFITS TO COMMUNITY

This project will support Department goals by improving mobility, vehicle delay times, efficiency, reliability, safety, and quality of infrastructure. This project will be designed with the community in mind and in turn, these improvements will benefit economic competitiveness, energy conservation, and quality of life.
