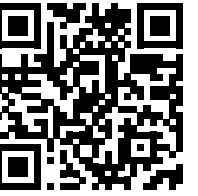




SR 31 Extension ACE Study Factsheet

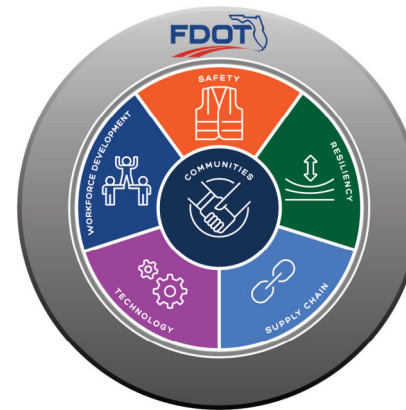
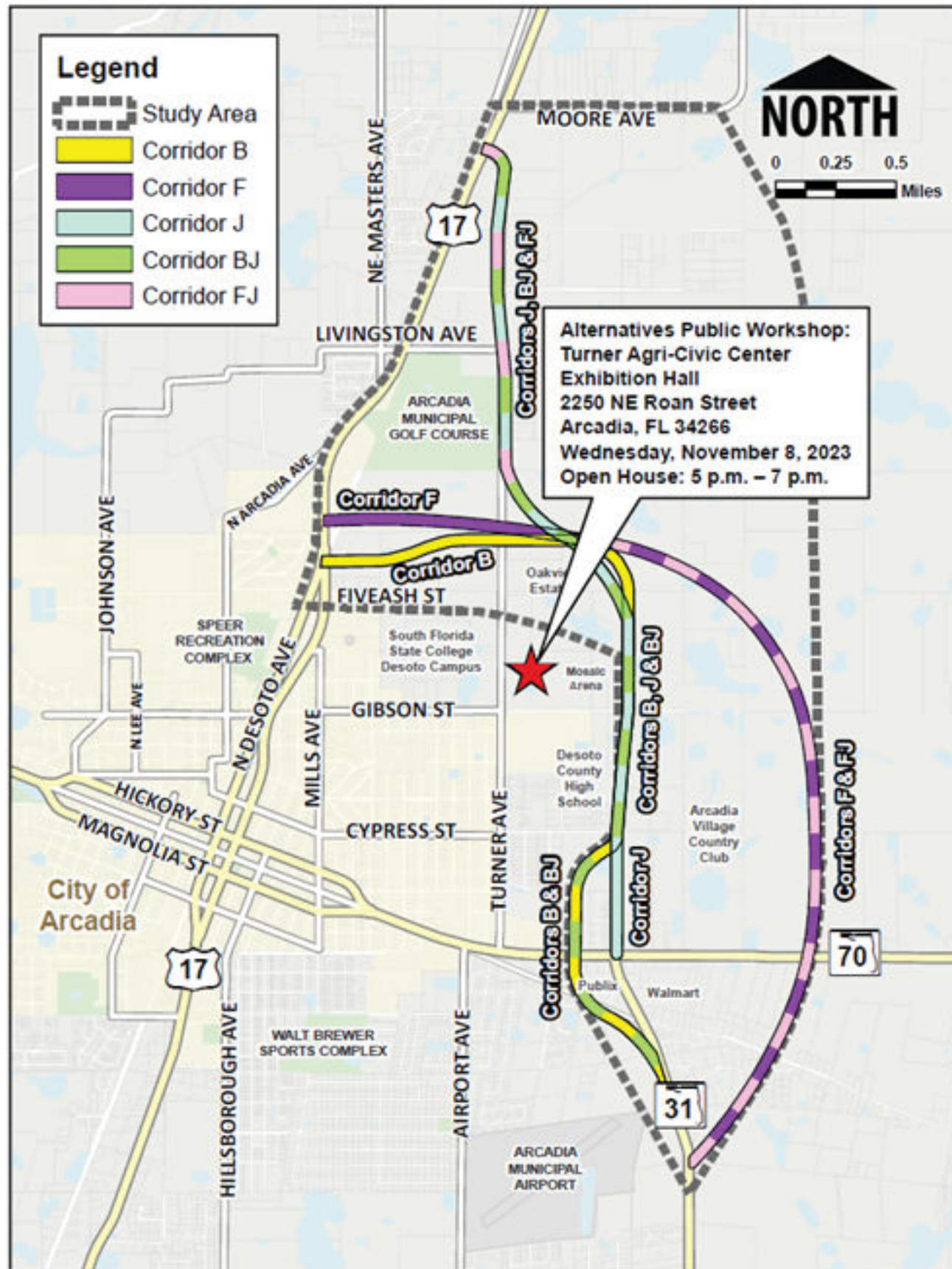
PROJECT DESCRIPTION

New roadway alignment north and east of Arcadia extending SR 31 from SR 70 to US 17 based on previous Alternative Corridor Evaluation (ACE), per Desoto County's TPO LRTP. Initial construction of 2 lanes with an ultimate 4 lane typical section with potential roundabouts.

The proposed new alignment would provide a new connection between SR 70 and US 17 and include accommodation for bicycles and pedestrians. It would improve safety by removing truck traffic from downtown Arcadia, improve economic development by improving access to undeveloped northeast Arcadia, improve evacuation times, and improve regional freight connectivity for truck traffic using SR 31.
