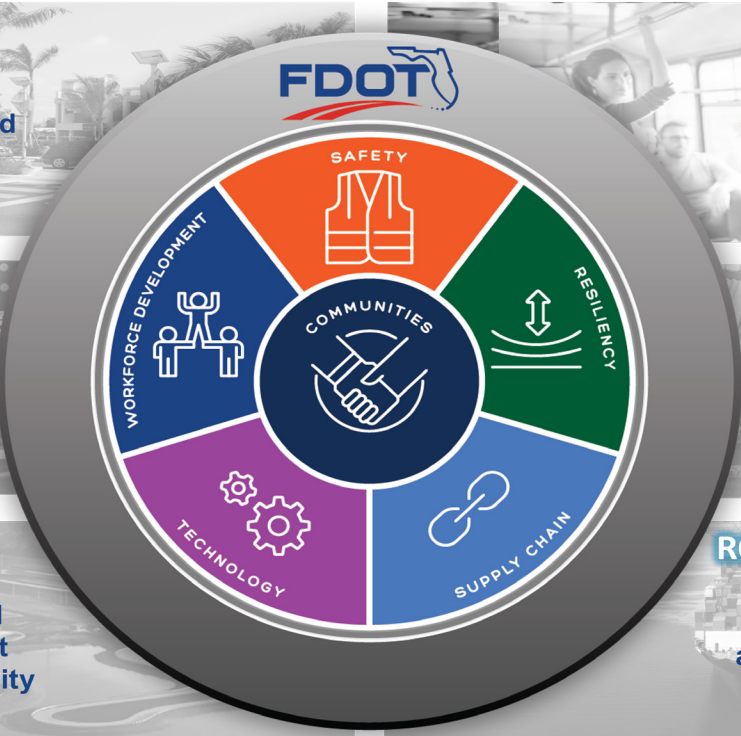

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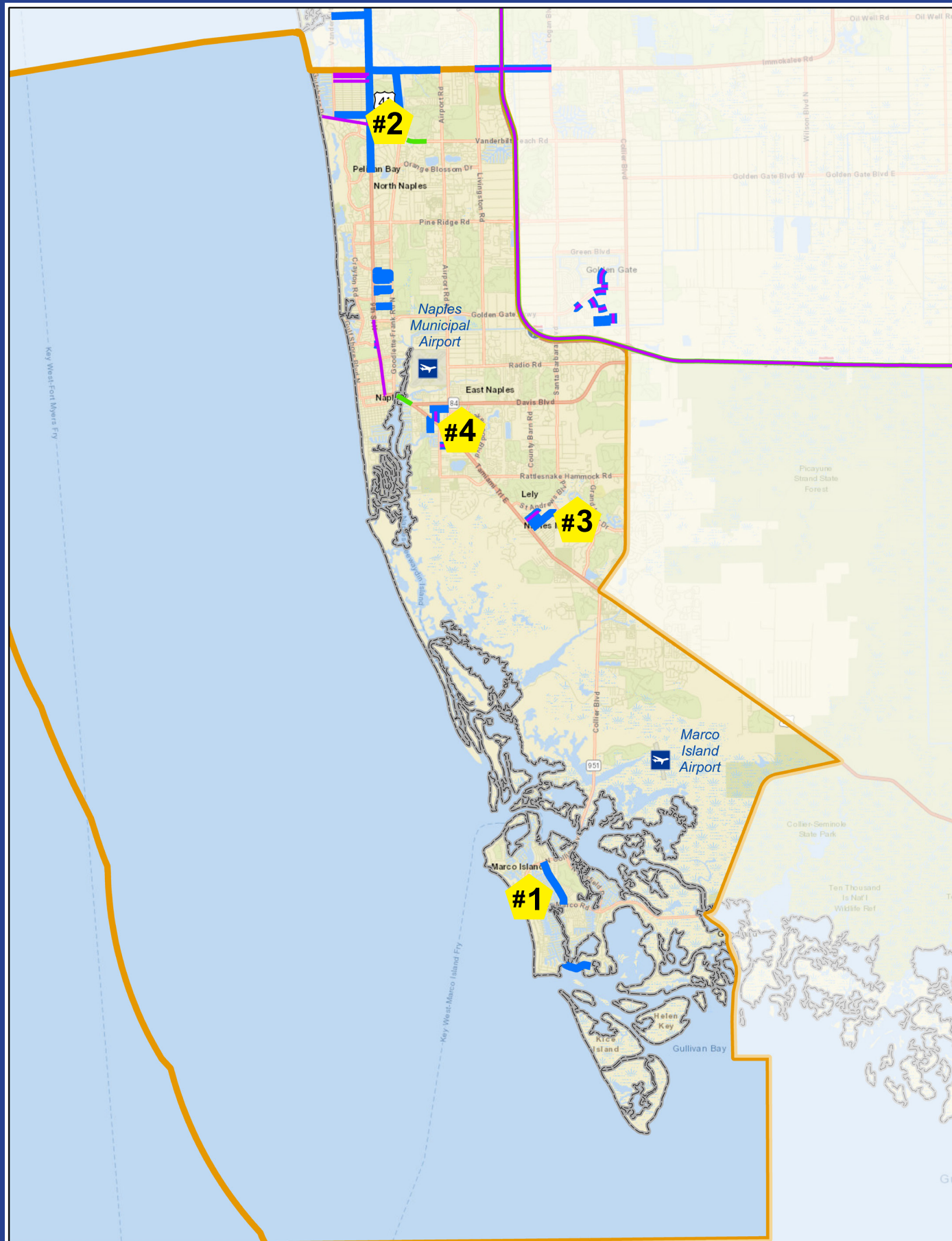
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DISTRICT ONE PROJECTS OF INTEREST

PD&E STUDIES, DESIGN, and CONSTRUCTION

- Benefit and transform our communities by providing essential safety improvements for motorists, pedestrians, and cyclists to achieve Vision Zero
- Add capacity and traffic flow strategies to mitigate congestion for our travelers
- Design innovative intersections and roadways to modernize our roads; and, enhancing safety, mobility, and connectivity with new trails, bike lanes, and sidewalks.

#1: BALD EAGLE DR FROM SAN MARCO RD TO N COLLIER BLVD

- FPID: 452209-1
- Construction - This project will provide 5-ft wide asphalt in-road bike lanes so that faster cyclists can safely ride in the roadway and travel in the same direction as vehicle traffic, thus avoiding cause of accidents.
- FY 2027
- Total Cost: \$1,467,281

#2: GOODLETTE FRANK RD FROM VANDERBILT RD TO IMMOKALEE RD

- FPID: 446341-1
- Construction - Widening the road from 4 lanes to 6 lanes will relieve traffic congestions on the State Highway System, and provide for the efficient movement of people, goods, and services.
- FY 2027
- Total Cost: \$5,500,000

#3: NAPLES MANOR SIDEWALK - VARIOUS LOCATION 4 SEGMENTS

- FPID: 448129-1
- Construction - The project includes a 6-foot wide concrete sidewalk along the south side of the road and other improvements and safety features include crosswalks, drainage improvements, and signing and marking.
- FY 2026
- Total Cost: \$2,346,880

RESURFACING PROJECTS

- Preserve, maintain, and enhance our system by extending the roadways' lifetime
- Provide a smooth ride to reduce wear and tear on our vehicles
- Install safety measures which may include wider bike lanes, pedestrian crossing devices, and modified medians to protect our fellow roadway users
- Upgrade traffic signals with modern, smart equipment.

#4: SR 45 (US 41) FROM N OF OLD US 41 TO S OF GULF PARK DR

- FPID: 441512-1
- Resurfacing
- FY 2027
- Total Cost: \$23,909,254
