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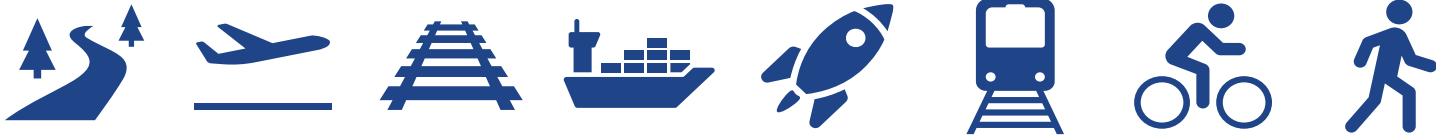

About FDOT District One

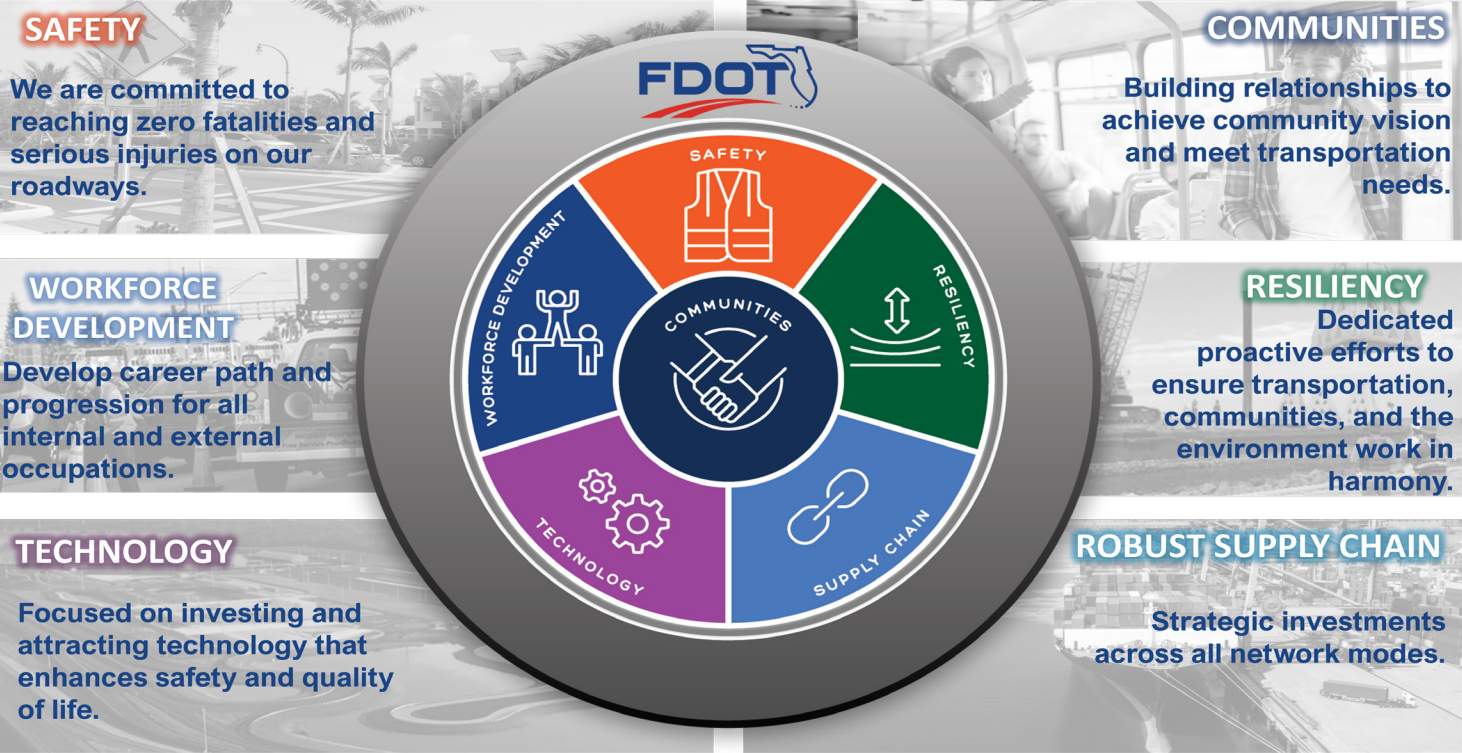

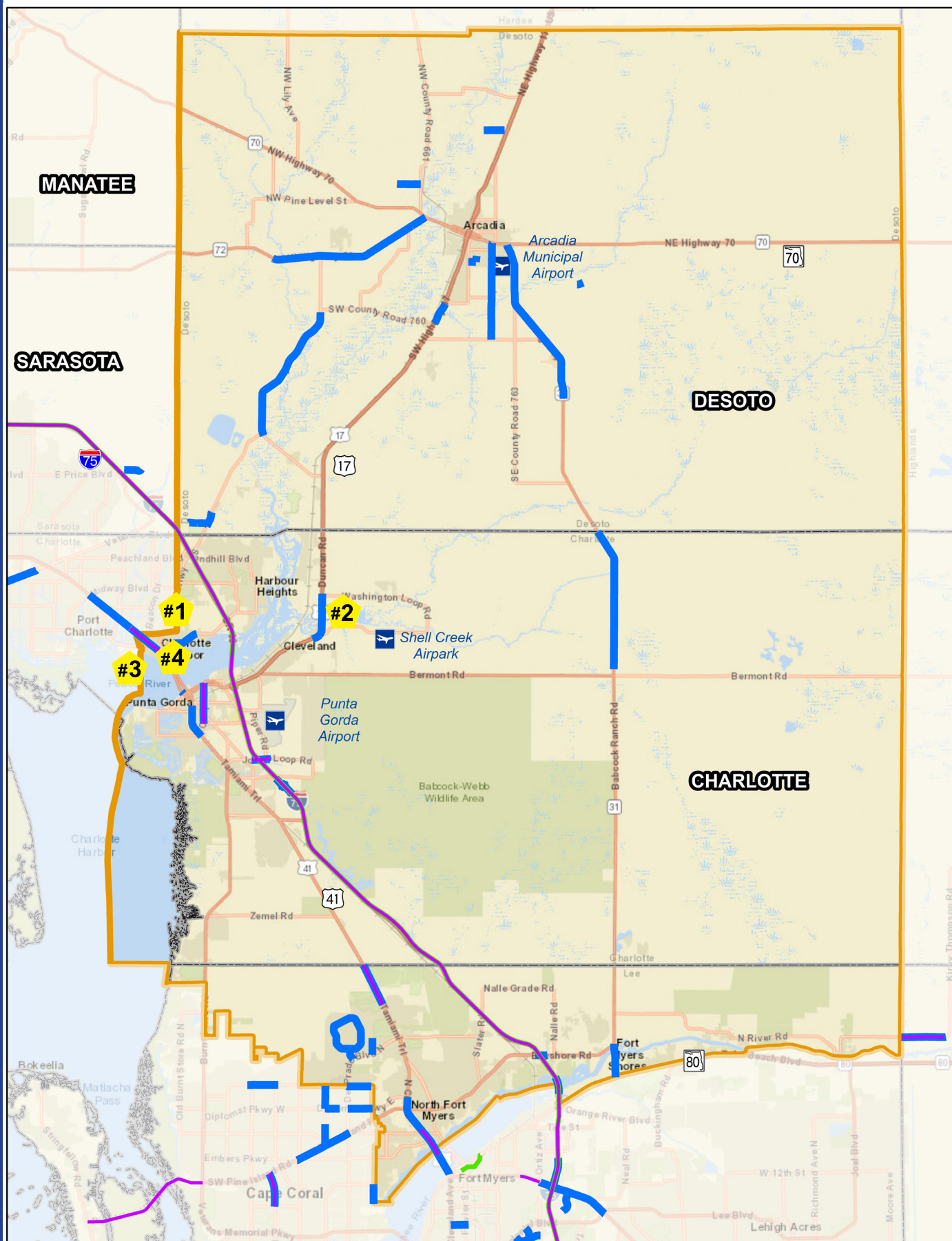

PD&E STUDIES, DESIGN, and CONSTRUCTION

#1: HARBORVIEW ROAD FROM MELBOURNE ST TO DATE ST

- Construction - Widen Harborview Road from a two-lane road to a four-lane road that will be median divided. Install new sidewalks. A Roundabout is proposed at the Melbourne St. intersection.

RESURFACING PROJECTS

- Preserve, maintain, and enhance our system by extending the roadways' lifetime
- Provide a smooth ride to reduce wear and tear on our vehicles
- Install safety measures which may include wider bike lanes, pedestrian crossing devices, and modified medians to protect our fellow roadway users
- Upgrade traffic signals with modern, smart equipment.
