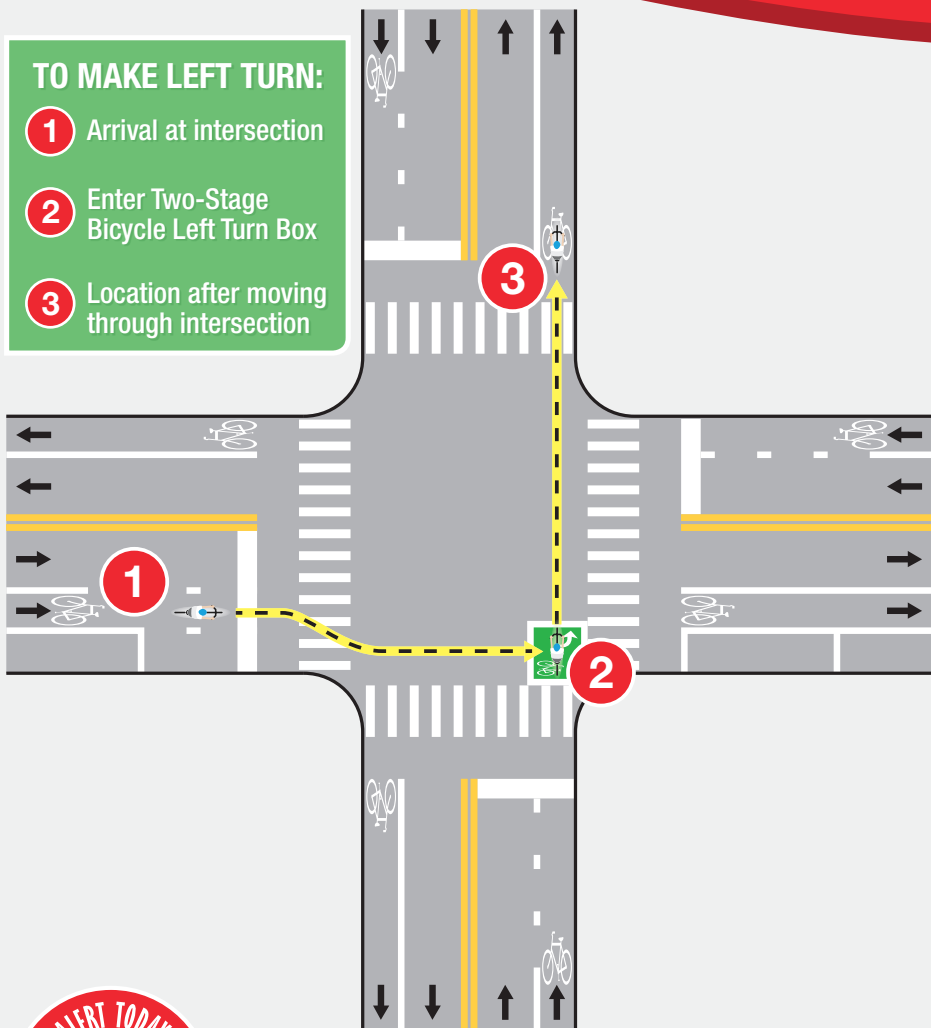


Two-Stage Bicycle Left Turn Boxes

allow left-turning bicyclists to choose between merging into traffic to make the turn or remaining in the bicycle lane as directed in the diagram below.

TO MAKE LEFT TURN:

- 1 Arrival at intersection
- 2 Enter Two-Stage Bicycle Left Turn Box
- 3 Location after moving through intersection



Your guide to Two-Stage Bicycle Left Turn Boxes



How bicyclists use a Two-Stage Bicycle Left Turn Box:

1. Enter the intersection on the green signal.
2. Stop in the green box and reposition your bicycle so it is facing the correct direction.
3. Wait for the green signal, then proceed through the intersection.



What motorists do in an intersection with a Two-Stage Bicycle Left Turn Box:

1. During a red signal, wait behind the stop bar for the traffic signal to change — no right turn on red.
2. Proceed through the intersection with care. If there is no bicycle lane, allow the cyclist to proceed through the intersection first.
