





About

The purpose of this design project is to address the existing operational deficiencies of I-75 and Daniels Parkway Interchange within Lee County and to accommodate future travel demand projections because of forecasted population and employment growth.

The interchange improvements include Improvements include reconstruction of the Daniels Parkway Interchange (Exit 131) converting it to a Diverging Diamond Interchange (DDI) design, reconstruction of the I-75 ramps, construction of pedestrian and bicycle accommodations through the interchange, installation of new signals at the ramps, and resurfacing of Daniels Parkway through the project area.
