





About

The Florida Department of Transportation expects to begin work milling and resurfacing S.R. 66 from U.S. 17 (S.R. 35) to Charlie Creek on August 15, 2024. The project limits encompass approximately 7.8 miles and crews will also install drainage pipes and structures, guardrail, sidewalks, new signage, curb and gutter, pavement markings and other safety improvements. The project will be completed in phases, with one of the phases encompassing a closure of westbound S.R. 66 from Merle Langford Road to U.S. 17 for several months.
