

About

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin milling and resurfacing approximately four miles of S.R. 789 from the Coquina Park entrance to S.R. 64/Manatee Avenue West in fall 2025. In addition to milling and resurfacing, crews will install traffic monitoring devices and will apply new signing and pavement markings.

The estimated project cost is \$3 million and estimated completion is early spring 2026. To minimize inconvenience, the project will be done overnight. Noise is to be expected. The project was accelerated to start just after turtle nesting season ends on October 31, 2025, and is expected to finish before the next nesting season starts on May 1, 2026.
