



The typical section for the proposed project consists of a multi-lane roundabout (RAB) with travel lanes that vary from 12 to 14', a 170' inscribed diameter, and a 16 to 32' wide circulating roadway. The drainage will be a combination of a closed system utilizing curb and gutter and on open system with roadside ditches.

## **Design Project Begins**

The project will construct a multi-lane roundabout at the intersection of Drane Field Road (State Road 572) and Waring Road, and remove the existing mast arm traffic signals. The proposed roundabout design will require the addition of storm sewers, inlets, closed flumes, and manholes for stormwater conveyance.
