CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) will begin the next phase of roadway and safety improvement construction along a 1.4-mile area of US 41 from Caribbean Drive to Stickney Point Road in Sarasota County, FL. Work consists of implementing safety improvements along the corridor, including resurfacing, lighting and signalization, median improvements, improved drainage, shoulder reconstruction, improved sidewalks, improved bicycle lanes, and curb and gutter improvements.

Construction of improved sidewalks Construction of improved bicycle lanes New signing and pavement markings Shoulder and median improvements Lighting, signalization and intelligent transportation systems

Milling, resurfacing, curb and gutter

PROJECT SCHEDULE


- Construction starts the end of October 2022 Expected completion is spring 2023 Overnight lane closures are anticipated. Expect noise from back-up alarms, trucks, and construction equipment.
- Estimated cost: \$9.9 million
