CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation began a safety improvement project on US 27 from Blue Heron Boulevard in Haines City to Holly Hill Cutoff Road in Davenport in March 2022.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Resurfacing US 27 and side street entrances
- Adding a new signal at Holly Hill Cutoff Road
- Widening for bike lane striping at the right turn lanes
- Improving the turn radius at southbound US 27 to westbound Sanders Road
- Adding high visibility crosswalks at Bates Road, Sanders Road/Davenport Boulevard, and Holly Hill Cutoff Road/North Boulevard West
- Installing street lighting at all signalized intersections
- Making minor drainage improvements

PROJECT INFORMATION

- Construction began Thursday, March 17, 2022 and ends in early 2023, weather permitting.
- Lane closures can be expected at night/overnight between 7 p.m. and 6 a.m.
- Some daytime lane closures are possible.
- Construction costs are estimated at \$6.3 million.
