

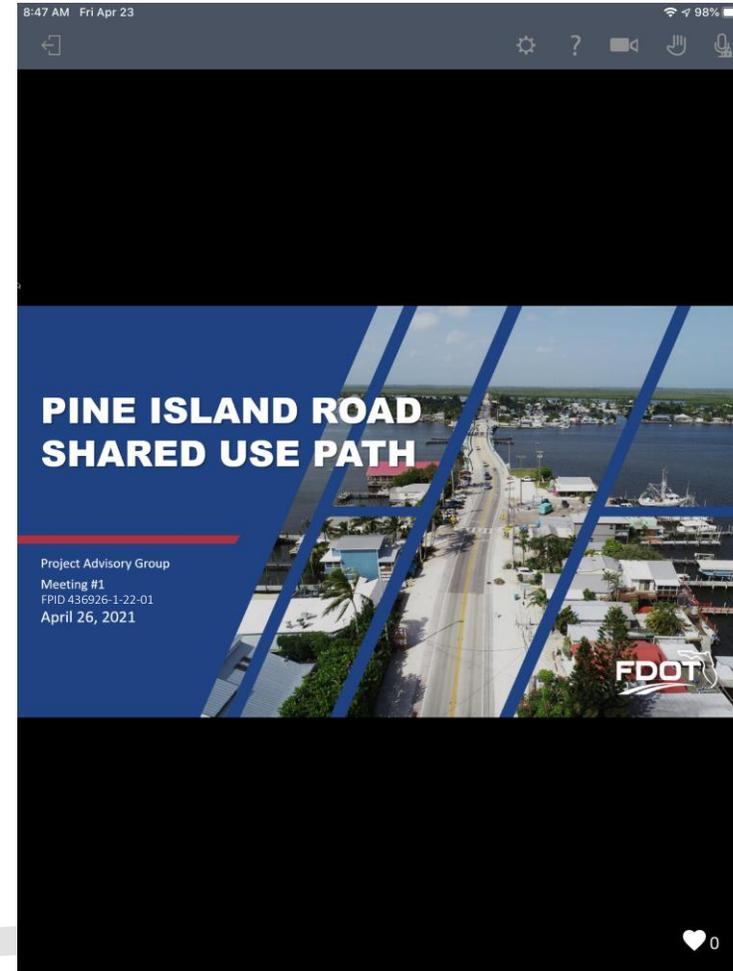




- ◆ FDOT administering project on behalf of Lee County

- ◆ Holistic approach with community






