

FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF TRANSPORTATION US 441 (PARROTT AVENUE) FROM NE 5TH STREET TO NE 9TH STREET **CONSTRUCTION BEGINS JUNE 1, 2021**

CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

Improvements to US 441 (Parrott Avenue) from NE 5th Street to NE 9th Street in Okeechobee County will begin on June 1, 2021. During construction, US 441 will be closed for up to 10 days starting June 14 at 6 a.m. Local traffic will be permitted to access businesses within the project limits, which are less than a mile and are shown below.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Repave US 441 (Parrott Avenue) from NE 5th Street to NE 9th Street for a railroad crossing reconstruction
- Add pedestrian signals at the intersection of NE 9th Street and US 441
- Install curb and gutter, new signage and pavement markers
- Add a northbound left turn lane at NW 7th Street
- Improve drainage
- Estimated construction cost is \$818,000

PROJECT SCHEDULE

- Construction begins June 1, 2021; estimated completion is fall 2021
- US 441 (Parrott Avenue) will be closed from NE 6th Street to NE 9th Street from June 14 at 6 a.m. through June 23; please follow detour route(s) and use caution in the area; law enforcement officers will be on-site to help guide motorists
- During construction there will be intermittent lane closures on northbound and southbound US 441, weather permitting
