CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

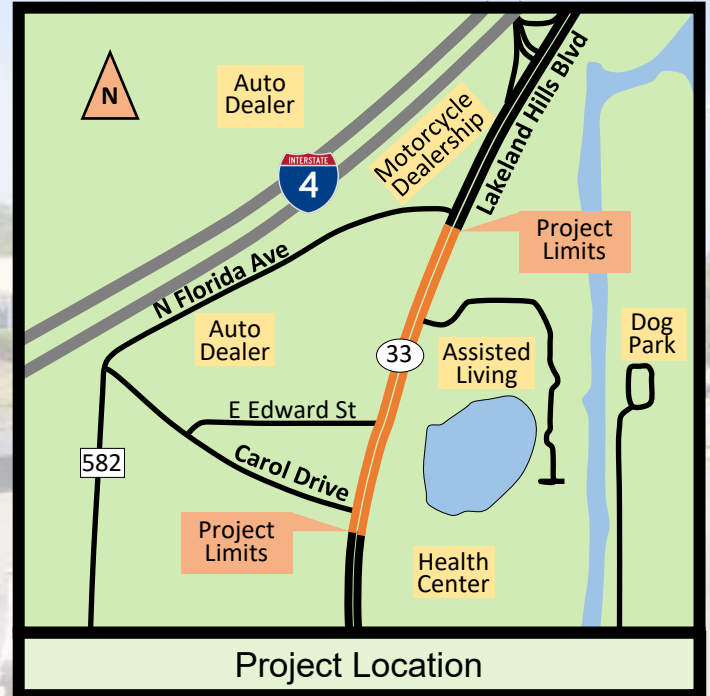
The Florida Department of Transportation began a safety improvement project on SR 33 (Lakeland Hills Boulevard) from south of Carol Drive to south of North Florida Avenue in April 2022. Following a safety study performed in 2016, temporary changes were made to the median at Carol Drive. This project provides permanent changes.

PROJECT IMPROVEMENTS

- Adding a permanent northbound left turn lane into Carol Drive and eliminating the southbound U-turn lane.
- Constructing a new southbound U-turn lane south of North Florida Avenue
- Resurfacing the roadway
- Improving drainage
- Reconstructing sidewalks to meet ADA requirements

PROJECT INFORMATION

- Construction began Monday, April 4, 2022 and ends in fall 2022.
- Most work is scheduled Sunday through Thursday nights.
- Lane closures are should be expected from 7 p.m. to 7 a.m.
- Construction costs are estimated at \$752,000.
