

SR 72 (Clark Road) PD&E Study From East of I-75 to Lorraine Road

PD&E STUDY BEGINS

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District One, is beginning a Project Development and Environment (PD&E) study for proposed improvements to State Road (SR) 72 (Clark Road) from east of I-75 to Lorraine Road in Sarasota County. The purpose of the project is to identify and evaluate potential improvements to this 3.39mile segment of SR 72. These improvements are intended to improve capacity to accommodate future travel demand projected as a result of area-wide population and employment growth. Other goals include enhancing safety conditions and accommodating multimodal activity.



SR 72 plays an important role in the transportation network as it facilitates east-west movement within Sarasota County for both local and regional traffic including truck traffic. SR 72 from east of I-75 to Lorraine Road is currently a two-lane undivided roadway with intermittent right-turn and left-turn lanes. Improvements may include widening to a four-lane divided roadway as well as bicycle and pedestrian accommodations such as a shared-use path.

WHAT IS A PD&E STUDY?

A PD&E Study is an environmental and engineering process developed by the FDOT to determine social, economic, natural, and physical environmental effects associated with a proposed transportation improvement project. The process follows procedures set forth in the National Environmental Policy Act of 1969 and federal and state laws and regulations. It requires the combined efforts of professional engineers, planners, and scientists who collect and analyze project-related information to develop the best solution for transportation needs. An important component of the process is public and agency coordination.
