PROJECT OVERVIEW

The objective of the project is to improve safety, enhance traffic flow, and reduce crashes at four (4) intersections along SR 683 (US 301): 12th Street, 17th Street, 21st Street, and Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Way. Improvements at all four intersections include:

- Resurfacing of the roadway
- · Striping for special emphasis crosswalks
- · Installing new signage
- Sidewalk and curb ramp reconstruction to meet ADA criteria



Improvements at the 21st Street intersection also includes adding a restricted crossing U-turn (RCUT) and Pedestrian Hybrid Beacons (PHB) on mast arm assemblies. Additional improvements include replacing and adding signal heads at the intersections of 12th Street, 17th Street, and Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Way.
