PROJECT OVERVIEW

The objective of this project is to improve safety along SR 33 (Lakeland Hills Blvd.) from Parkview Place to north of Granada Street. The project consists of complete reconstruction of the existing roadway and drainage system. The reconstruction will include a raised median from Parkview Place to north of Miami Street and a bi-directional left turn lane from north of Miami Street to north of Granada Street. Improvements also include:

- Replacing existing 5-foot sidewalks with 8-foot sidewalks
- Upgrading curb ramps and pedestrian signals to meet ADA criteria
- Modifying existing driveways to reflect current FDOT design standards
- · Providing street lighting on both sides of the roadway
- Upgrading traffic signal equipment and lighting at signalized intersections
- Storm sewer system replacement

Additionally, a new mid-block pedestrian crossing with a Rectangular Rapid Flashing Beacon (RRFB) will be constructed south of Channing Road and a new mid-block pedestrian crossing with a Pedestrian Hybrid Beacon (PHB) will be constructed north of Swannanoa Street.

This meeting is being held to present project information and provide an opportunity for the public to offer feedback. FDOT will accept written comments during and after the meeting. Please submit your comments by October 28, 2022, to be included in the formal public meeting record.
