Tips for using



GoToWebinar



Attendee Control Panel

Once you have joined the Webinar you will see the Attendee Control Panel and Grab Tab. The Control Panel contains panes that can be expanded or collapsed by clicking the ▾ at the top left of each pane.

(a) Grab Tab – Click the **arrow** to open/close the Control Panel. Click the **microphone** icon to mute/un-mute your audio. Click the **square** to toggle the Viewer Window between full screen and window mode.

(b) Audio Pane –Select your listening option.

(c) Questions Pane – Messages to attendees will appear here.

(d) Message Box – When the Message Box is activated, attendees can type their questions and submit them to the webinar host.

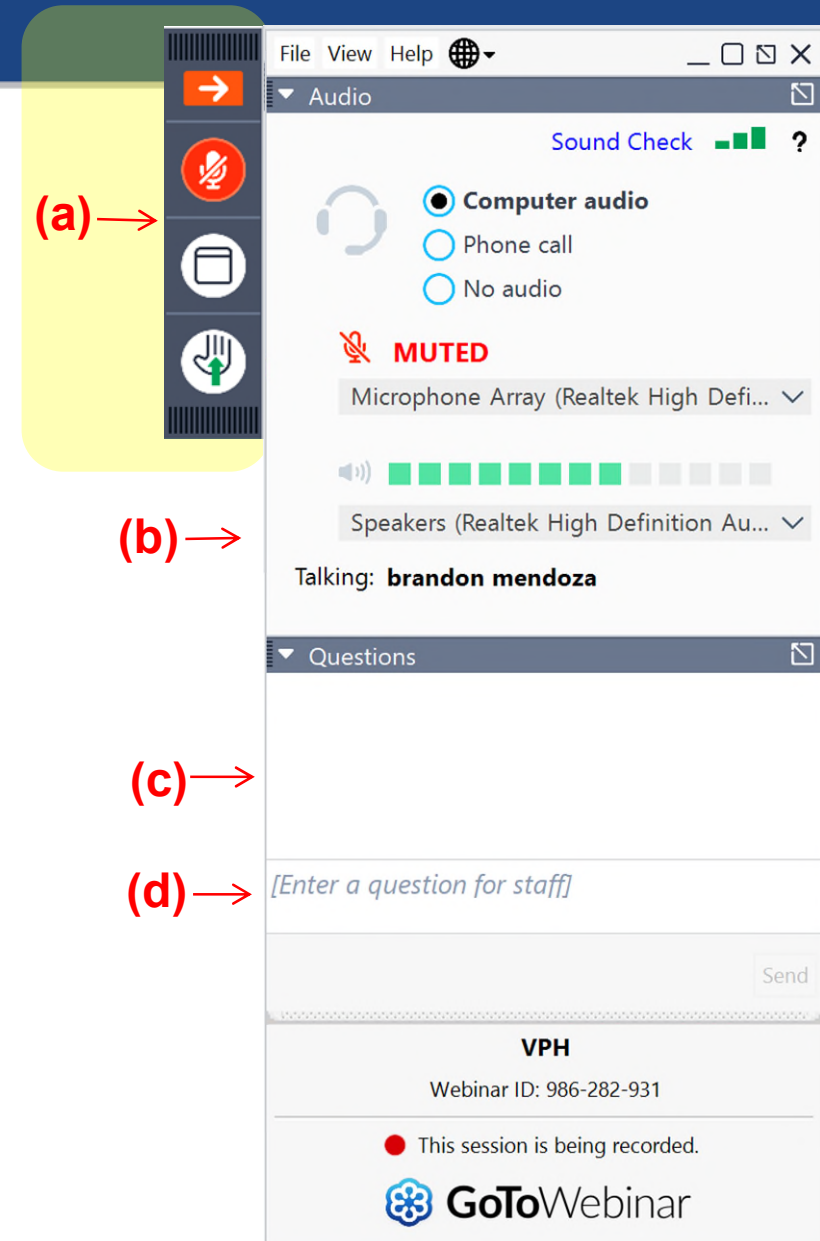

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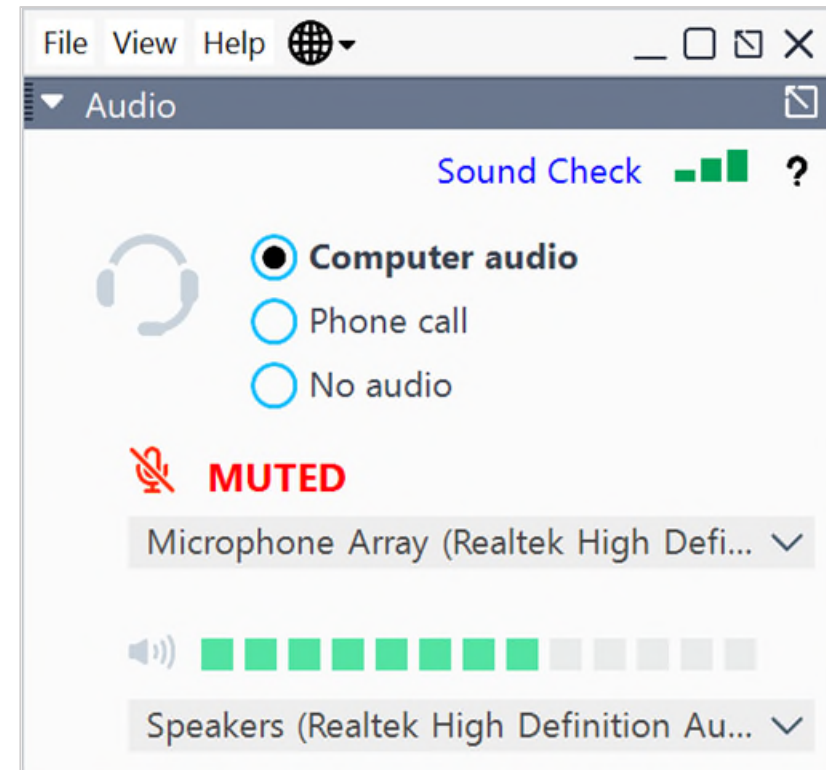

- Phone call



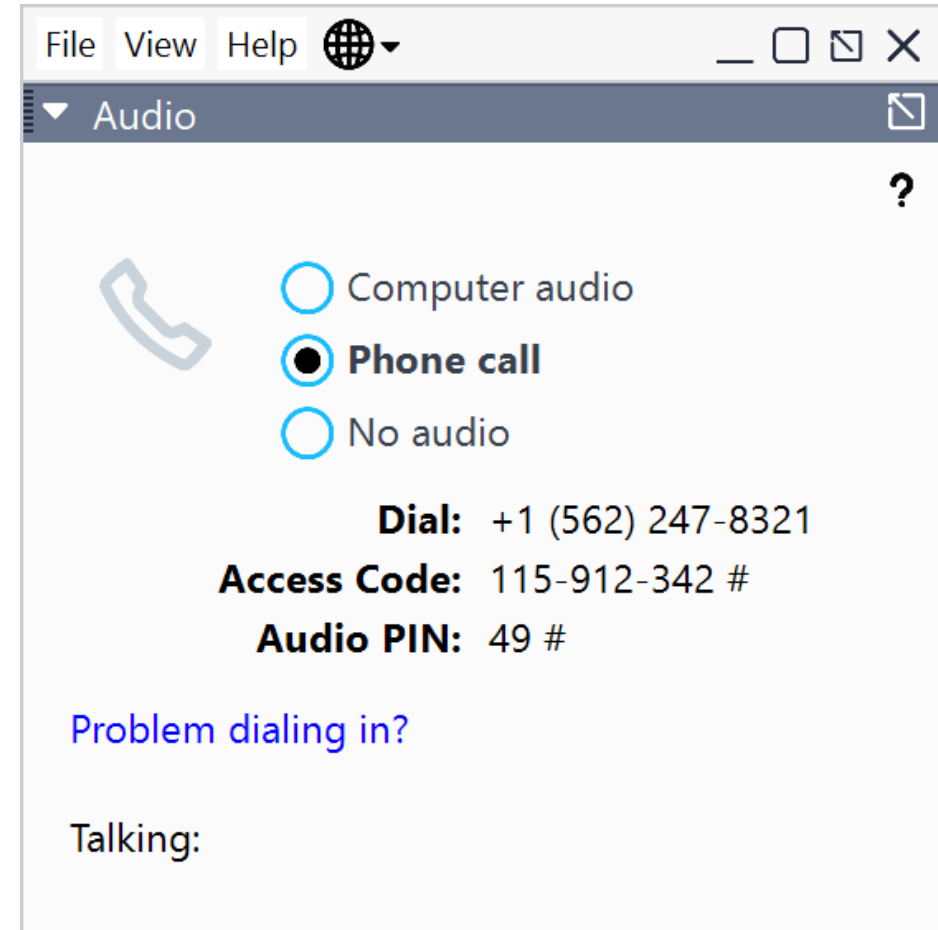
Note: If you choose to join via personal computer, you will need speakers to listen to the Webinar and a microphone to speak.

In the Audio pane, select **Phone call**.

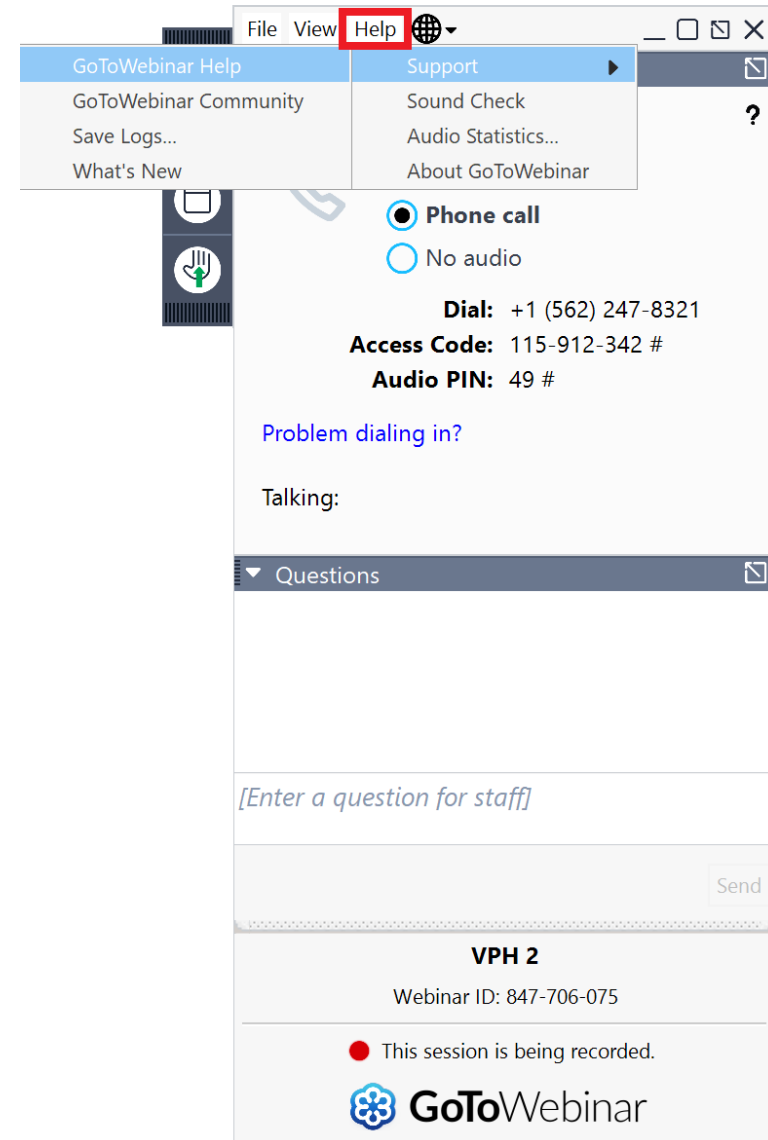
If you choose to join by telephone, dial the number provided and be sure to enter the **Access Code** and **Audio PIN** noted in your Audio pane.





Accessing Webinar Help

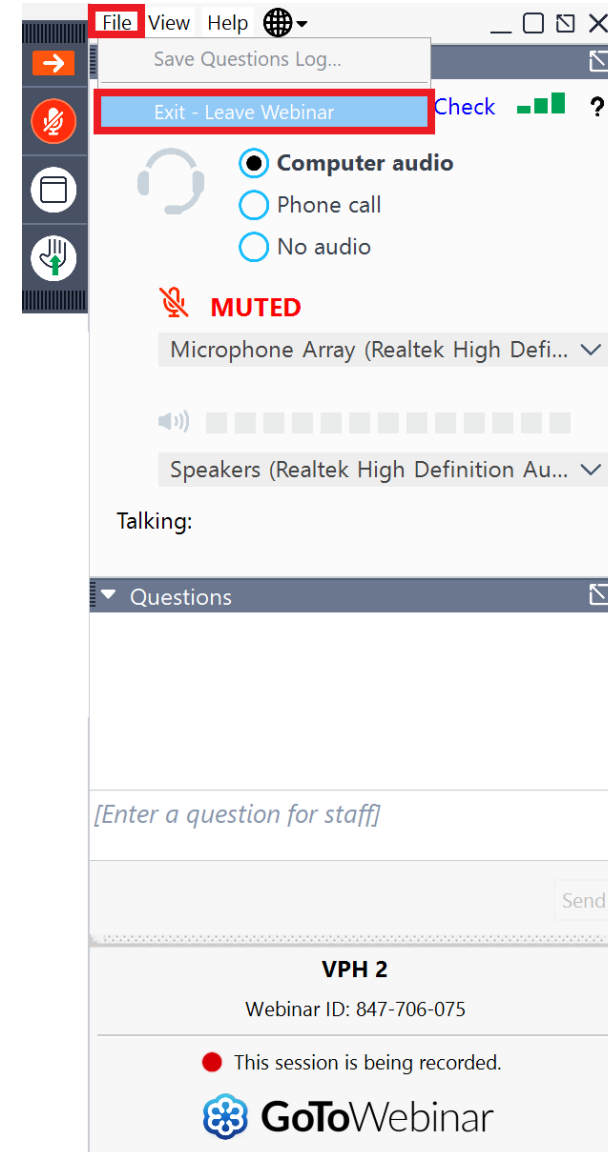
- Click **Help** at the top of the webinar Control Panel to access online help.

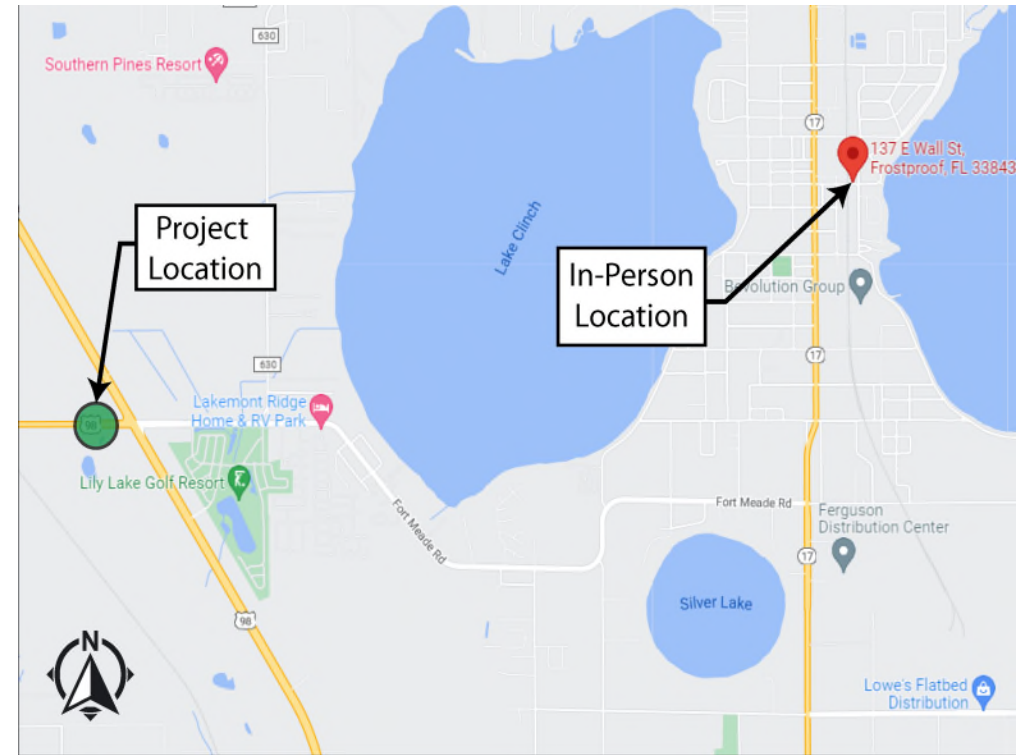

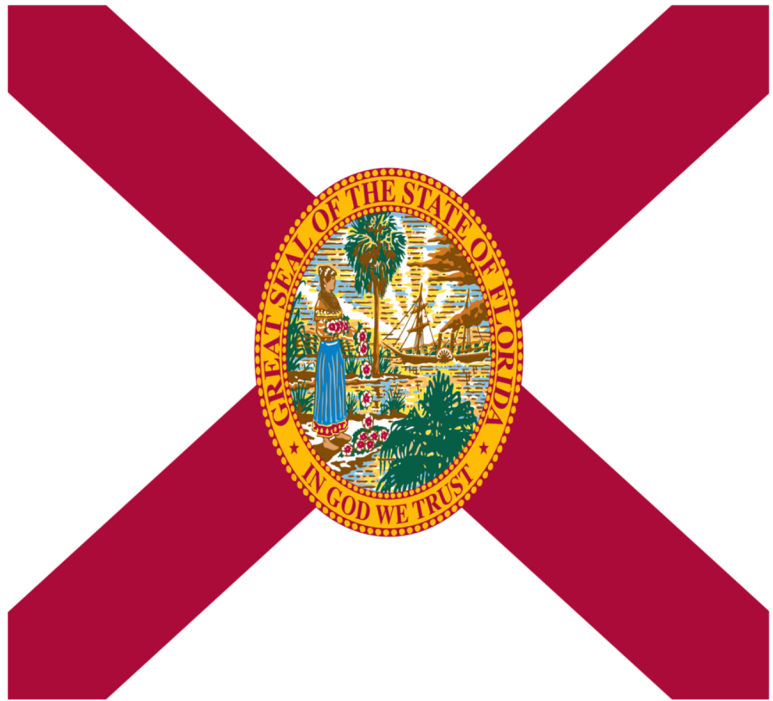

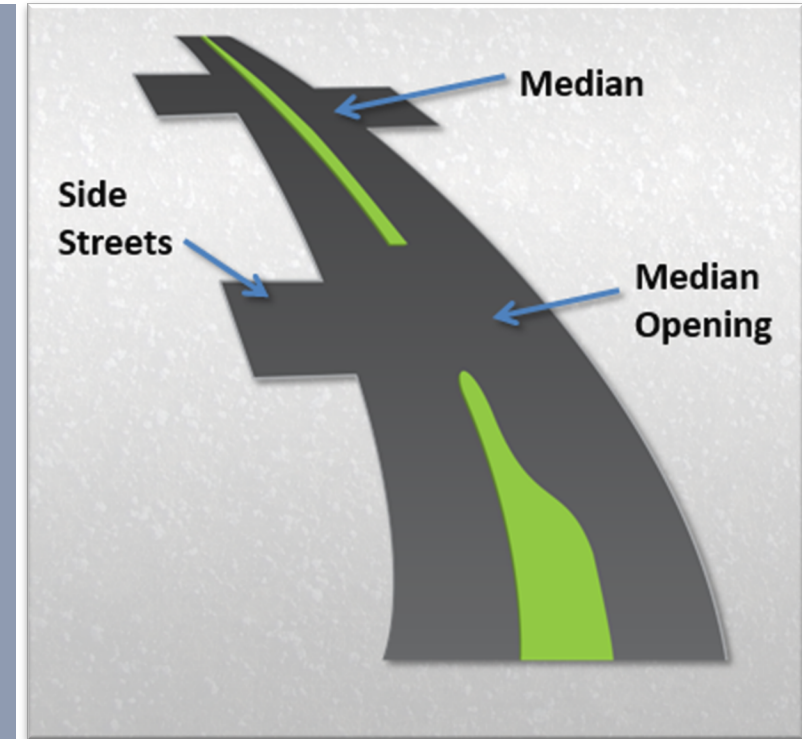


Median Modification Legislation

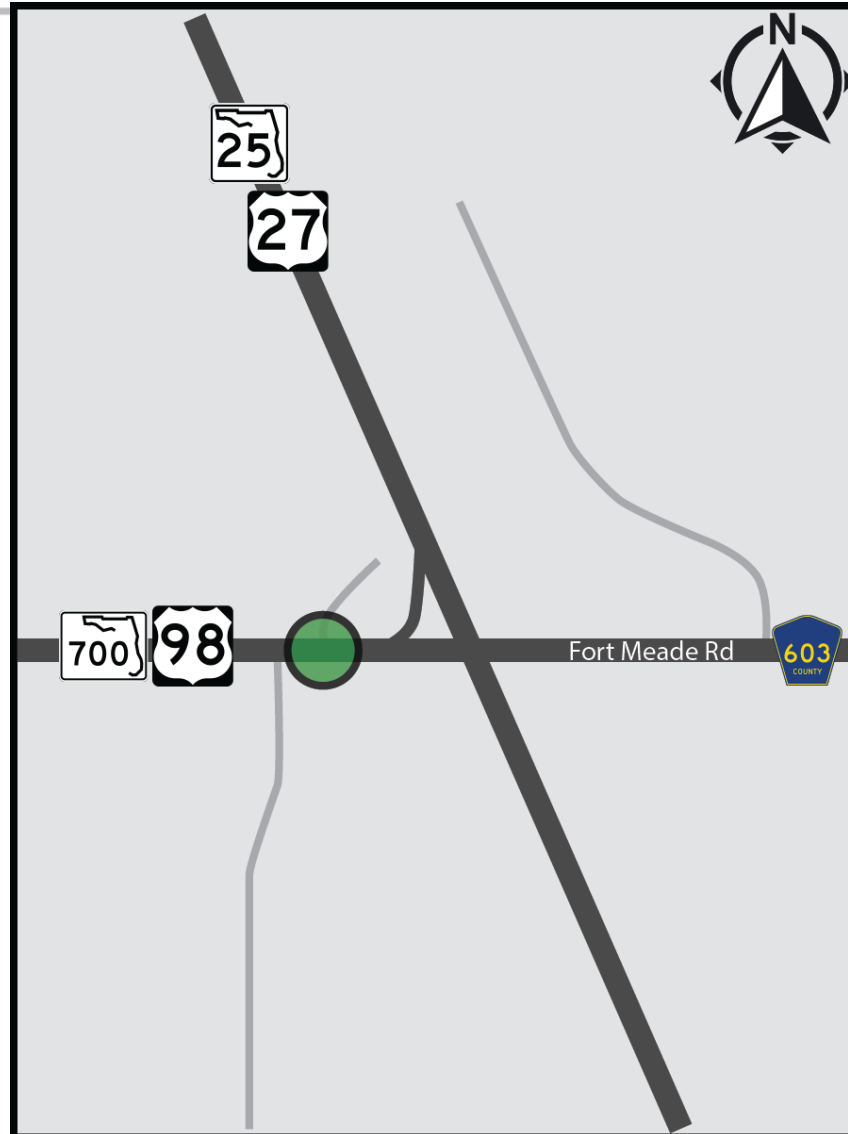

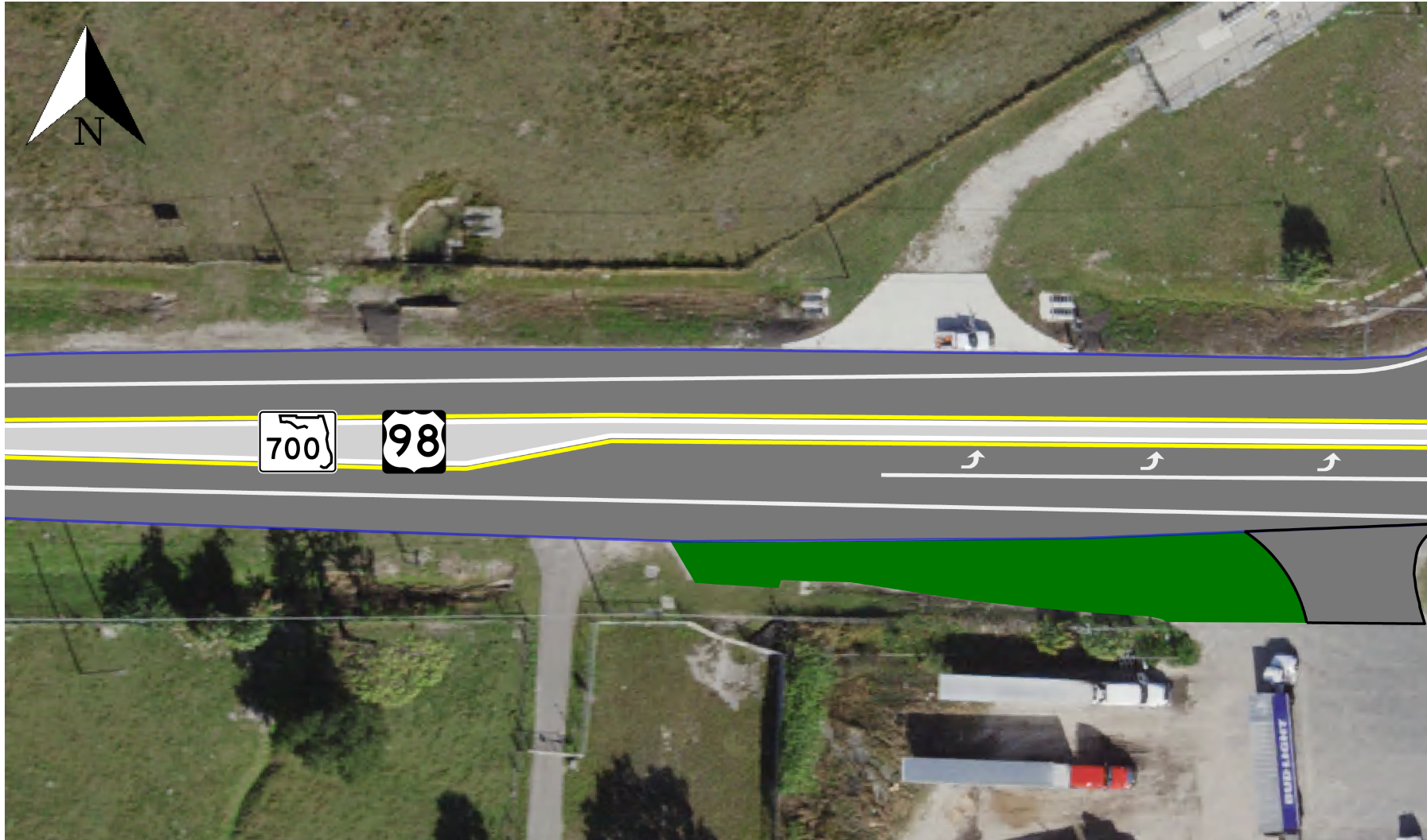


Existing Condition
