


WELCOME TO THE PUBLIC MEETING

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District One, welcomes you to the Public Meeting for the proposed improvements to the intersection of US 17 at Experiment Station Road / Lee Jackson Road. FDOT is hosting this Public Meeting to provide you wit the opportunity to express your views about the proposed improvement. Scan the QR code to view project website for additional details.



PROJECT OVERVIEW

To reduce crashes and increase safety, the full median opening at the intersection of US 17 at Experiment Station Road / Lee Jackson Road will become a two-way directional median opening. A two-way directional median opening is configured so that only vehicles traveling along the main roadway can access it to make a turn. Left turn and through movements from side streets are removed. This configuration has fewer conflicts points and provides improved visibility by managing the placement of vehicles within the median. This modification is expected to reduce the number of crashes at this intersection by 63%.



The improvement will consist of temporary curbing being installed in the median opening by the end of this year. Alternative improvement options are being considered for the intersection. FDOT will continue to evaluate those alternatives while monitoring the operations at the intersection after the temporary curbing is installed. Once a preferred alternative is determined, the design plans for long term improvements will be provided to you at a future meeting.
