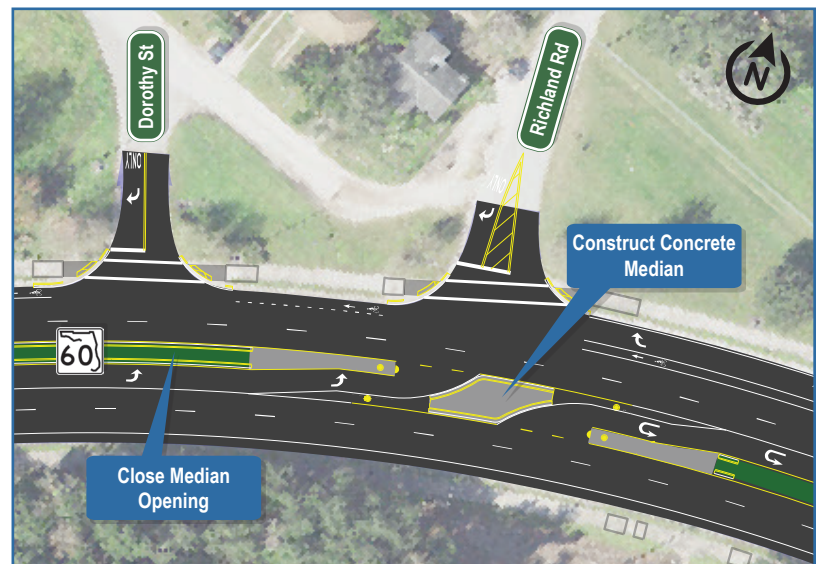
PROJECT OVERVIEW

The objective of this project is to extend the service life of the existing roadway and improve safety, enhance traffic flow, and reduce crashes to SR 60 from east of CR 555 to west of Broadway Avenue.

Proposed improvements include:

- Resurfacing of the roadway
- Restriping the roadway to include bicycle lanes in each direction
- Upgrading traffic signals
- Upgrading pedestrian signals at Baker Avenue
- Replacing signage
- Upgrading sidewalk and curb ramps to meet ADA criteria

Additionally, the project proposes implementing improved access control by closing the median opening at Dorothy Street and constructing a concrete median at Richland Road.



This meeting is being held to present project information and provide an opportunity for the public to offer feedback. FDOT will accept written comments during and after the meeting. Please submit your comments by March 17, 2023, to be included in the formal public meeting record.
