DeSoto Veterans Memorial Park is a public-use facility consisting of a boat ramp and picnic areas. This park is utilized by groups and for large events, to include Pioneer Days and Relay for Life. This park also features restroom facilities. DeSoto Veterans Memorial Park is located at 2195 American Legion Dr. in Arcadia, Florida. The park is approximately 14.33 acres. Other public boat ramps along the Peace River in DeSoto include: Brownville Park, Lettuce Lake Park and Boat Ramp, and Nocatee Boat Ramp. The park is assumed significant.

Relationship Between the Property and the Project

DeSoto Veterans Memorial Park is located adjacent to the project. The park is owned by DeSoto County. The park is accessible by vehicles off of SR 70 and can be accessed by pedestrians by utilizing the bridge over the Peace River, via W. Hickory Street. Access to the park will be maintained during and after construction. There will be no acquisition of land from this resource, no occupation of the resource on a temporary or permanent basis, and no proximity impacts to the resource.
