
Signals need to be warranted.

Signals increase crashes

High speed rear end Red light running

- Conflict points: Areas where paths legally cross within an intersection
- Reducing the number of conflict points increases safety
- Restricted Crossing U-turn 54% reduction fatal/injury






WHY ARE WE DOING THIS PROJECT?



30% of all traffic fatalities occur from intersection-related crashes.


