### Public Involvement Policy (000-525-050-i)

This is the Department's policy for public involvement.

#### Public Involvement Handbook

This <u>handbook</u> provides guidance for developing and implementing effective public involvement activities that meet federal and state requirements.

# Project, Development and Environment (PD&E) Manual

The PD&E Manual is the Department's procedure for complying with the National Environmental Policy Act (NEPA) and associated federal and state laws and regulations.

# Public Involvement (Part 1, Chapter 11 of the PD&E Manual)

This <u>chapter</u> provides guidance on public involvement activities regardless of project phase.

# Sociocultural Effects (SCE) Evaluation (Part 2, Chapter 4 of the PD&E Manual)

The SCE evaluation process described in this <u>chapter</u> identifies and addresses potential effects of transportation projects on communities and community resources, including potential issues associated with Environmental Justice, Civil Rights, and other nondiscrimination laws.

### FDOT Design Manual (FDM)

The FDM, <u>Chapter 104</u>, provides procedures and guidance for the preparation of contract plans for roadways and structure.

### Project Management (PM) Resource Guide

The PM Guide is the Department's resource to help project managers develop and deliver projects.

#### **Public Involvement**

This <u>chapter</u> discusses public involvement for project managers.

#### **Community Awareness Plan (CAP)**

This <u>chapter</u> discusses the components of a CAP that will carry forward during the construction phase.

#### Work Program Instructions

Public involvement requirements for the Work Program are in <u>Part 11</u>, <u>Chapter 2</u>. The Work Program Instructions are updated every year.
