The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT) wants you to be aware of an upcoming closure of the Caloosahatchee River Bridge in Lee County. In an effort to complete the **U.S. 41 over Caloosahatchee River Bridge Pedestrian Improvement** project a year ahead of schedule, the bridge will be **CLOSED** starting the evening of **May 31 through August 11, 2024**. During the closure, crews will complete the construction of the single median barrier, install new guardrail along the east side of the northbound lanes, and work on the sidewalk on the west side of the southbound lanes. Completing this project ahead of schedule will allow for improved safety to the traveling public and construction crews alike.
