## **PROJECT OVERVIEW**

As part of the previously completed Central Manatee Network Alternatives Analysis (CMNAA), several short term improvements were recommended to reduce congestion and enhance safety within the 13-sqare mile study area of Bradenton and Palmetto.

To improve downtown circulation, increase safety and enhance operations, the northbound left-turn movement at Manatee Avenue West will be prohibited. This will allow for the extension of the southbound left-turn lane at 6th Avenue West and allow traffic signals to work more efficiently to accommodate the heavy southbound left-turn volumes at 6th Avenue West. This improvement will result in northbound left-turning drivers being rerouted to turn right onto 6th Avenue West, turn left onto 8th Street West and turn left onto Manatee Avenue West.

The design of this project is in progress and anticipated to be completed in early 2024. Construction is funded for fiscal year 2024, with an estimated cost of \$685,000.
