

# Purpose



The purpose of this project is to construct a new sidewalk along Fort Thompson Avenue from State Road 29/Bridge Street to State Road 80/Hickpochee Avenue within the City of LaBelle in Hendry County.




# The Project Improvements Will Include



- Construct new concrete sidewalk
- Reconstruction of pavement near S.R. 29/Bridge Street
- Isolated locations of milling and resurfacing to install new crosswalk markings
- Drainage system upgrades consisting of a new closed-pipe conveyance system

- Work will be done in phases to reduce effects of construction on the community



- Access to businesses and residences will be maintained at all times
- Will minimize disruption to traffic flow in the neighborhood



- New concrete sidewalk to improve community mobility and safety
- Pedestrian ramps at the end of sidewalks at crossroads
