
About the Project

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District One, is designing improvements to SR 31 at CR 74 (Bermont Road) in Charlotte County. The limits extend several hundred feet each way from the intersection. The proposed intersection improvement consists of designing a roundabout to improve overall safety, and enhance connectivity.

Roundabout Benefits

A roundabout is much safer than a conventional signalized intersection. Safety for all modes of travel is improved with intersections with roundabouts. One benefit is an overall reduction in vehicle speed while still accommodating all traffic movements. Also, the number of vehicle-to-vehicle conflict points decreases from 32 to 8 for intersections with single lane approaches. Head-on and high-speed collisions are virtually eliminated. Other benefits include:

- Traffic Safety – Reduces injury crashes by 76%
- Operational Performance – Reduces overall delay
- Operations and Maintenance – Reduces costs
- Environmental Factors – Roundabouts are environmentally friendly
- Aesthetics – Can be landscaped
- Accommodates semi-trucks
