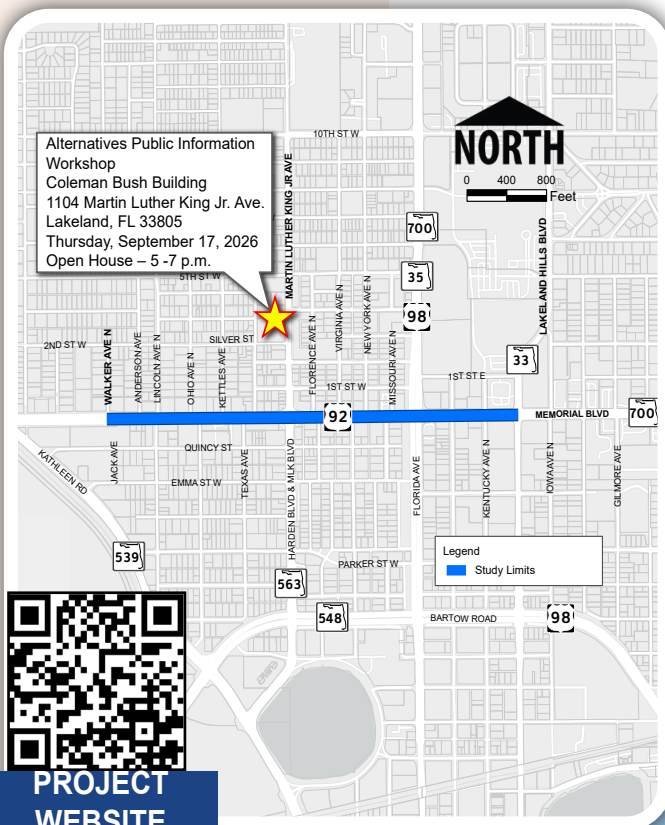

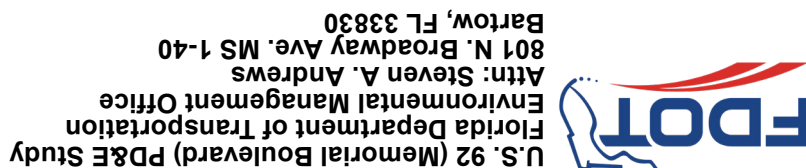

U.S. 92 (Memorial Boulevard) PD&E Study

ABOUT THE PROJECT:

FDOT, District One, began this PD&E study in June 2024 to evaluate safety enhancements from Walker Avenue to State Road (S.R.) 33 (Lakeland Hills Boulevard) in Polk County. This PD&E Study is an outgrowth of the Lakeland Area Alternatives Analysis (LAAA) Study and the Corridor Action Plan (CAP). U.S. 92 (Memorial Boulevard) is a priority corridor and the PD&E study will explore context-based solutions such as lane widths, traffic operation improvements, and pedestrian and bicycle enhancements along the corridor.
