Interstate 75 at SR 951/Collier Boulevard Interchange Improvements



CONSTRUCTION PROJECT

The Florida Department of Transportation is constructing interchange improvements on the Interstate 75 (I-75) at SR 951/Collier Boulevard interchange to improve highway operations, safety, and regional mobility.

Improvements include:

- Reconstruct the I-75 at Collier Boulevard interchange, converting from a diamond interchange to a modified diamond interchange
- Reconstruct the on- and off-ramps between I-75 and Collier Boulevard:
 - Construct two new fly-over ramps over Davis Boulevard; first serving as an off-ramp from I-75 southbound to Collier Boulevard southbound second serving as an on-ramp for Collier Boulevard northbound to I-75 northbound
 - Construct two new loop ramps; first serving as an on-ramp from Collier Boulevard southbound to I-75 southbound second serving as an on-ramp from Collier Boulevard northbound to I-75 northbound
- Add emergency stopping sites on off-ramps
- Intersection improvements at Collier Boulevard and Davis Boulevard
- Construct noise wall along I-75 southbound off-ramp to Collier Boulevard
- Resurface Collier Boulevard within interchange
- Bicycle and sidewalk improvements including new shared-use path



PROJECT COST

Construction costs are estimated at \$97.7 M

PROJECT SCHEDULE*

* Schedule is tentative, subject to change, and weather permitting

Stage I	Early 2023	- Mobilization - Maintenance of Traffic - Construct Noise wall - Drainage improvements - Widen and resurface Collier Boulevard - Temporary I-75 Widening - Utility relocations
Stage II	Mid 2024	- Widen I-75 - Reconstruct ramps - Construct Fly-over ramps
Stage III	Mid 2025	- Resurfacing - Install permanent lane striping - Install signage - Install traffic signals - Open completed interchange
