# **PUBLIC MEETING**

The Florida Department of Transportation (FDOT), District One, invites you to attend the Livingston Florida Power & Light (FPL) Trail Extension Project Development & Environment (PD&E) Study public meeting in-person on **Tuesday, November 18** or live online on **Wednesday, November 19**.

This study will evaluate a new 12-foot-wide separated shared-use path in Collier County.

The public meeting is being conducted to present information about the preliminary alternatives and provides the opportunity for the public to express their views about the project.

You can participate in the public meeting live online or in-person. The same material will be displayed at both the in-person and online meetings and will be posted on the project website.

#### **About the Project:**

The FDOT initiated the PD&E study in October 2024 to assess the feasibility of a new 12-foot-wide separated shared-use path in Collier County. This path is planned to extend from Radio Road to the Collier County line and is proposed as a component of the Shared-Use Nonmotorized (SUN) Trail Priority Network. This initiative aims to bridge a significant gap between the existing Rich King Memorial Greenway and Lee County's forthcoming SUN Trail network to the north.


